Managed by Mr. Cyril Spiers, the former Cardiff City Chief, Crystal Palace have adopted a policy of developing its own young players. This system has produced some outstanding young players, but as a team the Palace are having their troubles. With 27 points from 31 games they are not completely out of the danger zone yet.

Today's team shows one change, and two positional switches from that which was beaten last week by Gillingham. All the changes are in the forward line.

Harrison who was at outside-right last week is switched to the left wing to the exclusion of Murray, and Berry moves from inside-right to outside-right. This brings in Whitear at inside-forward. A rather surprise selection on the strength of some fine displays in the Football Combination Team, Whitear has been out of the first team since the start of the season.

When the two teams met at the County Ground last season the match ended in a 0-0 draw, and this was the score when we visited Selhurst Park earlier this season.
