Today's visitors to the County Ground, Norwich City, are fellow strugglers at the foot of the Division 3 South League Table. Their team today is composed, almost without exception, of players who have been with the Club for several seasons. In defence Ray Ashman, formerly a left-half now appearing at full-back, signed for the Club as far back as 1944, while Ken Oxford joined the Canaries from Chesterfield in 1951. In that year Ray McCrohan signed for the Club from Reading as an inside-forward.

The attack is almost the same with Peter Cordon joining Norwich in 1949 as an amateur from Northampton and William Coxon signing in 1951 the two oldest members.

This points to the fact that most of the Norwich team is of the older, but more experienced type player, a combination which is always useful in matches as vital as today's.

When Norwich visited the County Ground last season the game ended in a 1-1 draw, our scorer being Owen.


