The amount was £2,000 and approximately 15,000 people have been concerned in the gift. It is not vain repetition to say that we appreciate the efforts of our workers, and the loyalty of our patrons, who enable us to assist the Directors of the Football Club on a continued substantial scale.

We hear of other Clubs who are able to assist in the same manner, and of others whose efforts are not so successful, in spite of continuous and unflagging hard work.

In these latter cases it may be that the Clubs concerned are less fortunate in the matter of Competition Organisation, and, writing as representing the rank and file, we are very pleased to pay tribute to our Organiser, and his main assistants, whose efficient work is a vital factor in the success which has been achieved.

There are few who would be willing, in addition to working voluntarily for many hours during the week, to miss, usually, the first half of every match, in order to balance their cash and prepare their
