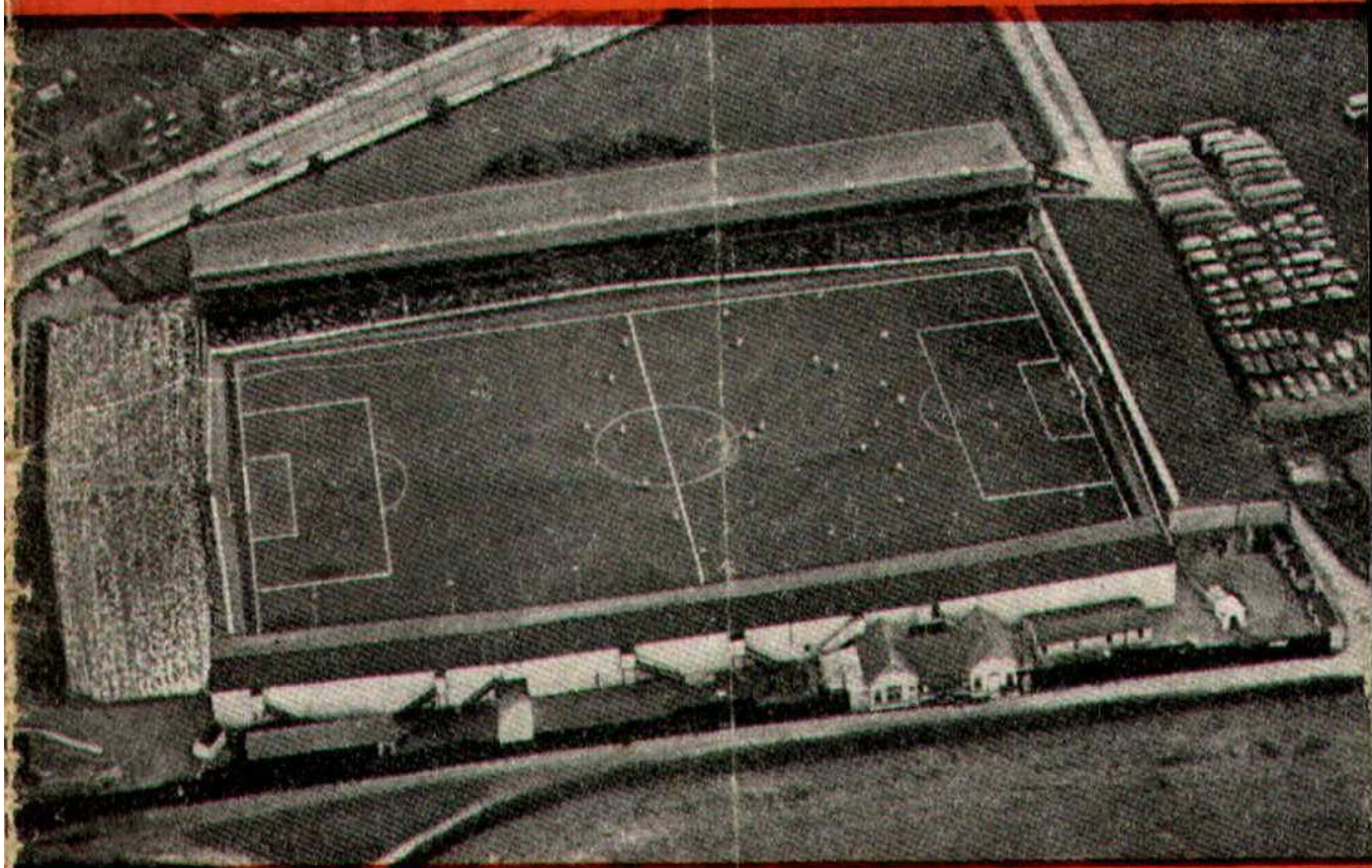

## CLUB NOTES

It is always interesting to listen to the comments of the crowd, as one leaves the County Ground after the game. 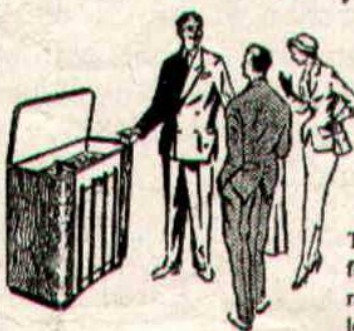
