

It is also responsible for the accommodation charges in the Olympic Village and for freight, insurance, etc. The Association has no source of income, except that which it derives from its appeal.

"It is hoped that a football team from Great Britain will qualify for one of the final 16 places in Rome, and we are appealing to all clubs in membership with the Football Association to help."

May we please also appeal to ALL our followers to support the match on Tuesday next, 26th April, kick-off 6.45 p.m. This game has been arranged to provide money for World Refugee Year. 
