

It will be seen that we are still moving in the right direction, but should like to reach the maximum of 15,000 members (i.e. £750 Gross per week) as soon as possible. There are 1,940 vacancies and we hope that any spectators, over 16 years of age, who may be interested will make applications.

We know that there are good supporters who do not agree with this way of raising funds, and hasten to add that we respect their views. We would press nobody to act against sincere convictions.

In the meantime a sum of £400 has so far been paid to the Football Club out of that part of the Competition Profit particularly appropriated to the Floodlight Fund, and £1,000 out of the remainder of the profit.

In addition, as already announced, £579 was paid over to the Floodlight Fund out of our General Funds.

The tickets for our Christmas Draw are now available, and members of the Competition will be able to obtain Draw Tickets from those Agents from whom they purchase their weekly tickets. The prizes are very attractive, and the tickets 1/- each.

We are grateful to friends who have kindly given prizes for this Draw.

In the meantime we renew our appeal for continued generosity when the collection is taken at half-time. The proceeds will again be devoted to the Floodlight Fund. The Collection at the Bristol City match realised more than £17 for this purpose—a very satisfactory sum. The players contributed indirectly, for a good display in the first half always puts supporters in a good and approachable mood.
