CLUB NOTES

Once again we entertain Shrewsbury Town, this time in the second round of the Football Association Cup. Without considering replays, that will mean six meetings between the two clubs in four months.

Unfortunately, for the second time this season, it was not possible for any football to be played on our ground. One wonders if the weather will ever improve. In fact, will the rain ever stop?

It is most unfortunate with our young team we should this year experience such a season, the worst for many years.

Everything possible has been done to improve the playing pitch. Consultants have been called in for advice on every subject. Experts on ground upkeep and playing fields machinery have visited the ground.

Men in charge of sports grounds have been brought in regarding drainage, and surveyors with complete knowledge of the geological structure of the area have been consulted on the actual pitch.

Drains have been opened up to ensure they are functioning properly and new ones added.

The question of plastic covering has also been considered. The cost would be in the region of £1,000, and it is easily damaged. Another factor too, is the County Ground is situated on a ridge of clay, and even if the surface water is kept away from the pitch, water collected in the neighbourhood would drain down to the clay subsoil.

However, no stone will be left unturned to improve the playing surface. The facts are however—far more matches are being played on the County Ground than ever before, the position of the ground on a clay belt, and the exceptional weather. At present it is one great fight against the vagaries of nature.

May the weather be kind during the next few weeks.

- M. GIBSON (Goalkeeper). Born at Derby, he joined the club from Nuneaton. Gained his place in the first team this season when Shrewsbury played at Swindon in the Football League Cup.
- G. SKEECH (Left Back). Joined the Club from Runcorn the Cheshire League Club in Nov. 1954. Has now made the left back position his own and takes a well earned benefit this season.
- A. HARLEY (Left Half). A Chester-born lad, was previously on the ground staff before signing professional. Converted from a winger to wing half and is now fulfilling the early promise shown.
- J. WALLACE (Right Half). The only Scottish player on the books who was found playing at a nearby Army Camp and was signed professional after being demobbed. A very fine ball player, at home either at wing half or centre half.
- G. WALTERS (Right Back). A Wolverhampton-born lad, was signed from a Wolverhampton Works side in 1957 and has been a near ever-present for the first team since signing professional.
- D. POUNTNEY (Centre Half). A Salop-born lad who last season became a full-time professional after being part-time. At home at either inside forward or in the half back line. Strong and forceful player.
- J. McLAUGHLIN (Outside Left). A close season signing from Birmingham City. A fast and clever winger from whom much is expected in the future.



SUPPORTERS' CLUB NOTES

The late Mr. Frederick Payne was a founder member of this Club and served on the Committee for many years. He was an enthusiastic and conscientious worker, until illness prevented his attendance at the County Ground. We extend our condolences to his relatives.

A further sum of £1,200 is being handed over to the Directors of Swindon Town F.C., out of our Competition profits. £200 of this had been earmarked to the special Floodlight Fund, but we understand that the Directors will also devote a further £250 out of the general donation, for the same purpose.

Competition membership is still growing steadily. On 12th November the number had reached 13,120. We still look forward to covering the maximum 15,000 permitted.

The profit on the date mentioned was £316 but it would exceed £400 weekly if we could achieve the maximum membership.

Seldom have the correspondence columns of our local press produced such acrimony as recently. "Thoroughbred Swindonions" have joined forces against "Proud Hammersmithians" regarding allocations of houses.
