Here lies the Club's greatest problem. With attendances at the level of say 9,000—and this should not be impossible in a town of the size of Halifax—we should have no real worries and could go ahead with more enterprising team building and ground improvements.

But with public support at its present level it becomes a question as to how long we can maintain a place among the leaders of the Third Division.

I would therefore, appeal to lovers of sport in Halifax to rally round the club by giving us regular and whole-hearted support and encouragement.


