Unfortunately the unrealistic build up of some of our young players not only affects their play, but also their mental make-up. We are all human, and these lads, young as they are, must have some impression made on their minds.

We sincerely trust this sensationalism will soon cease. One final word: when we read of the fantastic sums supposed to be in the offing, we wonder what is or was the real worth of Maurice Owen.

After this evening's game we play away to Northampton on Saturday, and then on Monday we entertain Birmingham in the replay League Cup-tie. Kick-off 7.30 p.m. This has caused quite a congestion of fixtures for both teams. On the Wednesday follow-

BARNSELY F.C.

We are pleased to welcome the Directors, Officials and Players of Barnsley F.C. to the County Ground this evening. When the Club visited Swindon last season we won 1-0. Our scorer was E. Hunt.

Pen pictures of the players from whom the team will be selected are as follows:-

Clarrie Williams (Goalkeeper)

Born Newcastle. Ht. 5ft. 10in. Wt. 10st. Former clubs, Doncaster Rovers and Grimsby Town. Clarrie, who was signed on the deadline in the 1959-60 season, had his senior chance in the Club's F.A. Cup run last season. He has succeeded Don Leeson, who is with the Grimsby Police Force.

Colin Swift (Right Back)

Born Barnsley. Ht. 5ft. 8in. Wt. 11st. 2lb. Colin, like so many Barnsley first teamers, is a product of the consistently successful Barnsley Schoolboys' team. Colin is steady without any flourishes.

Eric Brookes (Left Back)

Born Staincross, Barnsley. Ht. 5ft. 11in. Wt. 10st. 8lb. Eric, another product of schoolboy football, made his League debut last season for Barnsley when only sixteen and on the ground staff. He

later played for the England International Youth team. Towards the end of the season he signed as a full-time professional. He shows fine promise.

Bobby Wood (Right Half)

Born Elphinstone, Scotland. Ht. 5ft. 9in. Wt. 12st. 13lb. Bobby joined Barnsley from Hibernians ten seasons ago as an inside forward. Last season he starred in Barnsley's Cup run at right half. A grand clubman, Wood is hard to dispossess.

Frank Bartlett (Inside Right)

Born Chester-le-Street, Co. Durham. Ht. 5ft. 10in. Wt. 11st. 4 lb. Frank has played in every forward position and one season scored fifteen goals from outside left. He has played consistently at wing half over the past few seasons, but returned as goal-getting inside forward midway through last season.

Duncan Sharp (Centre Half)

Born Haigh, Barnsley. Ht. 6ft. Wt. 13st. 5lb. Sharp is a 100 per cent clubman who has earned the reputation of being one of the most effective stoppers in the Third Division. No game is lost until the final whistle with Duncan, who is an ex-miner.

Billy Houghton (Left Half)

Born Barnsley. Ht. 5ft. 9in. Wt. 11st. 3lb. Billy is a former England Youth International wing half with a strong line in attacking play. He often joins the attack for a shot at goal.

Born Grimethorpe. Ht. 5ft. 5in. Wt. 10st. 4lb. Ronnie is another ex-Barnsley schoolboy player. This is his second spell at Oakwell, for he joined Barnsley from the Boys' team. Then he went to Lincoln City.

Bert Tindill (Centre Forward)

Born South Heindley. Ht. 5ft. 8 in. Wt. 11st. 10lb. He was formerly with Doncaster Rovers and Bristol City. Joined Barnsley in the 1959-60 season and is the schemer of the attack.

Jack Swindells (Centre Forward)

Born Manchester. Ht. 5ft. 9in. Jack was previously with Blackburn Rovers and Accrington Stanley. He joined Barnsley in the close season. He scored seventeen goals for Stanley last season.

Ken Oliver (Inside Left)

Born Chester-le-Street. Ht. 5ft. 10in. Wt. 12st. Ken, clever with his head, was signed from non-League club South Shields a couple of seasons ago. He quickly became a crowd-favourite with his goal-scoring ability.

George Jagger (Outside Left)

Born Great Houghton. Ht. 5ft. 8in. Wt. 9st. 2lb. George joined the club from local football as a winger, then he developed into a useful wing half, in which position he made his League debut last

season. Towards the end of the season he blossomed out as a left winger again.

Alan Green (Full Back)

Born Dodworth. Ht. 5ft. 8in. Wt. 12st. Alan is a part-time professional. Outside football he is a council surveyor. He played usefully last season when the club was hard hit by injuries. Joined Barnsley from local football.

Roy Sawyer (Centre Half)

Born Worsborough Bridge. Ht. 6ft. Wt. 11st. 2lb. Roy, another local product, made his first-team debut last season.

Steven Mokone (Inside Forward)

Ht. 5ft. 7in. Wt. 10st. South African international. He had a spell three seasons ago with Cardiff City F.C.; last season he was with the Portuguese Club, Sports Lisboa Benefice.

Allan Hopper (Full Back)

Born Newcastle. Ht. 5ft. 9in. Wt. 11st. 7lb. Allan, a very reliable defender, joined Barnsley last season from South Shields, the non-league club. He was a regular member of Barnsley's reserve side last season.

Barrie Wood (Inside Forward)

Born Doncaster. Ht. 5ft. 9in. Wt. 11st. Barrie joined Barnsley last season from South Shields and towards the end of the season made his League debut. Barrie has previously played with Doncaster Rovers and Scunthorpe United.
