Club Notes

These notes have to be written before the match at Northampton. There is an old saying, "Everything goes wrong when one is down." That surely is the way of the luck with Swindon Town F.C. at the moment. Barnsley came to us on Tuesday last, smarting from a home defeat 0-3, and then on Saturday we are forced to visit Northampton and play them on a rebound of a 0-3 home defeat by Bournemouth. However, let us hope for better things, and Swindon has recorded its first win of the season, and that away from home, although Northampton has never been a very happy hunting ground for the "Robins".

Mention of the luck going against us, many spectators thought Swindon very unfortunate indeed to have a goal disallowed against Barnsley early in the second-half. The decision was made by the linesman on grounds of offside, but it must have been a very near thing, as Smith, the scorer, appeared to be behind the ball, and had to move forward to head it into the net. Had a goal been awarded, Swindon would have been in a good position, with a lead of two goals. The tragedy was made greater because a few minutes later Barnsley scored an equaliser from from what appeared to be an offside position. However, there it is; we just have to accept these decisions. Let us hope the luck will soon turn in our favour.

This evening's game should greatly boost the spirit of our team. They begin with the knowledge of a draw at Birmingham, and it is an incentive to play against a First Division team.


