A season of great opportunity

THE North Country air suits Bristol City, their last two games away to Bradford and Carlisle United having realised full points.

Both games were won by a 5-2 margin and with 21 goals to their credit City have scored more goals away from home than any other club in the four divisions of the Football League.

The success at Carlisle, Manager Fred Ford's old club, was the fourth out of the eight away games played to date, and 10 of the 17 points standing to City's credit have been obtained away from home.

This is a season of great opportunity for Third Division clubs. The competition has seldom been so keen, and the position in the League table is wide open.

After going the first four matches without a win, the side has made a remarkable recovery, and are well up with the leaders.

Ten points from eight away matches is promotion form, but unfortunately the results at Ashton Gate have not been so good.

This is an unusual record. City have seen plenty of the ball in their home matches, but have not been able to produce the finishing touch.

The club has again been hit by injuries, and the latest casualty is Alex Tait, just when he was finding his best form on the right wing.

Young Roger Peters now has his chance, and he helped the side on the way to victory with a goal soon after the start at Carlisle.

Bobby Williams found his goal-scoring touch with two, while Brian Clark and Jantzen Derrick kept up their good work with a goal apiece.

Owen soon hit the headlines, and he refused tempting offers from Wolves and Arsenal. He is now serving the club well at centre-half.

Full-backs Terry Wollen and John Trollope, wing-halves Keith Morgan and Bob Woodruffe, and forwards Summerbee, Ernie Hunt and Cliff Jackson were all in the first team when they were only 17.

Mike O'Hara, goalkeeper, joined Swindon from Luton Town last season. He is 18 and was a regular first team player until he was injured.

Mike Turner, goalkeeper, recently completed his National Service in the R.A.F. He was signed from Dorchester Town, and got his chance when Mike O'Hara was injured last season.

Terry Wollen, right-back, is a local boy who made his debut for the first team when 16.

John Trollope, left-back, another local boy who started with the groundstaff. He has been a regular player since 1960-61, when he made his debut at the age of 16.

Keith Morgan, right-half, is a strong attacking player from Westbury, Wilts.

Maurice Owen, centre-half, captain and veteran of the side. Formerly a free-scoring centre-forward, he has been with the club since 1947.

Bob Woodruffe, left-half, is another local born player who joined the club straight from the Swindon Boys' team. He also played at centre-forward and inside-forward.

Mike Summerbee, outside-right, was born in Cheltenham, and has graduated from Swindon's youth team. He started as a centre-forward.

Ernie Hunt, inside-right, joined the groundstaff from school. A local boy, he also made his debut when he was 16, and has been top scorer for the past two seasons.

Jack Smith, centre-forward, joined Swindon from Watford in 1961. He was formerly with Hartlepool United.

Cliff Jackson, inside-left, another Swindon boy and schoolboy international. He made his first team debut when he was 17.

Arnold Darcy, outside-left, joined the club in November 1956 from Wigan Athletic. He is stockily built, forceful, and a good shot.

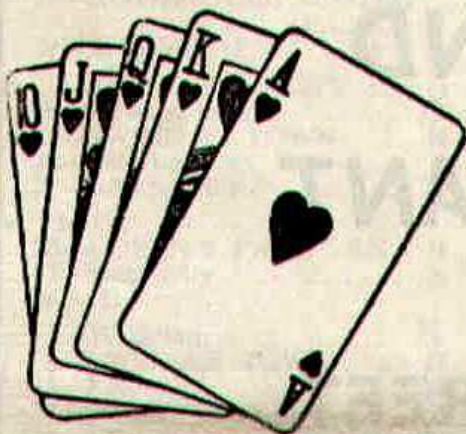
