Terry Wollen (right-back). A local boy who made his debut for the first team when 16 years old. He played the majority of first team games during season 1960/61 and last season.

John Trollope (left-back). A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the first team at the beginning of the season 1960/61 when he was 16 years old.

Keith Morgan (right-half). A strong attacking wing-half who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Played in every first team game during 1960/61 and missed only three games last year through injury.

Ken McPherson (centre-half). Signed from Newport County in August, 1961. He is a player with a reputation for hard work.

Maurice Owen (centre-half). The team captain and oldest member of the team. Formerly a centre-forward, he has had a long and outstanding period of service with the club.

Bob Woodruff (left-half). Another local born player who came to the town direct from the Swindon Schoolboys' team. Has played at centre-forward and inside-forward in the senior side and his performances have made him a target for several trasfer offers.

Mike Summerbee (outside-right). Born in Cheltenham, he is another product of the Swindon Youth policy. Formerly at centre-forward, but has now made the outside-right berth his own.

#### For the Record . . .

Today's tie is the 12th time Yeovil have reached the 2nd Round of the F.A. Cup. Our record (including replays) is as follows:—

P W D L F A 15 6 4 5 25 24

The first time we reached this stage of the Cup was in 1931/32 when Yeovil shocked the football world by drawing 0—0 at Fulham. In the replay all attendance records at Huish were smashed when a crowd of 8,004 saw Fulham win by 5—2.

Of the eight Football League Clubs beaten by Yeovil in the F.A. Cup all have been at Huish, with the exception of the I—0 defeat of Walsall in 1960/61. Results of other League Clubs beaten are as follows:—1924/25 Bournemouth 3—2, 1934/35 Crystal Palace 3—0 and Exeter 4—1, 1938/39 Brighton 2—1, 1948/49 Bury 3—1 and Sunderland 2—1, 1958—59 Southend I—0,

Our visitors today were one of the founder members of the Southern League in 1894/95, when they finished bottom with only 9 points from a possible 32. In 1909/10 they were runners-up to Brighton and the following season won the league by 3 points from Northampton.

In 1919/20 they left the Southern League to enter the Third Division South where they remained until the introduction of the present Division 3.
