## CLUB MATTERS

### Our Visitors—Swindon Town F.C.

Last Tuesday night over 20,000 spectators were at the County Ground, Swindon to see the 'Railwaymen' beat Shrewsbury Town by one goal to nil and make certain of a place in the 2nd Division next season.

On behalf of everyone at Boothferry Park we offer to the Swindon Town club our congratulations on gaining promotion and wish them well in the higher Division. Success for Swindon Town has been very well deserved for they have maintained the strong challenge necessary for promotion right through the season having been in one of the top three positions in the League table nearly all the time. It will be the first time Swindon Town have played in the 2nd Division as all their previous football has been played in Divisions with a 3rd Division tag.

Though until recent seasons Swindon Town may have been virtual strangers to us they in fact have been in League football for many years. They became a professional club in 1894 just 13 years after they were founded in 1881. They operated in the Southern League from the time they became a professional club until 1920 when they became one of the original clubs in the 3rd Division. In 1921 this became known as the 3rd Division (South) and Swindon continued to compete in this Division, with the exception of the war years, until 1958 when they were one of the clubs gaining 3rd Division status on the formation of the present 3rd and 4th Divisions. Since this time they have continued to consolidate and improve their League position season by season culminating in the reward of promotion this year.

Today's visit will be the fourth that Swindon Town F.C. have made to Boothferry Park and it will be the 8th meeting between them and the 'Tigers'. The results of the previous seven encounters are most certainly in favour of the Southern club, as the following details will show:—

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## PEN PICTURES OF SWINDON TOWN PLAYERS

**MIKE TURNER** (*Goal-keeper.*) Just demobbed from the R.A.F., he joined the Club whilst still in the services from Dorchester Town. Took over in goal following the injury to O'Hara last season and is expected to make strong bids for the first-team position this season.

**MAURICE OWEN** (*Centre-half.*) The team captain and oldest member of the team. Formerly a centre-forward, he has had a long and outstanding period of service with the Club. Has played in several representative games.

**JOHN TROLLOPE** (*Left-back.*) A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the Season 1960/61, when he was 16 years old and was ever present during that season and last season.

**KEITH MORGAN** (*Right-half.*) A strong, attacking wing-half, who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Played in every first team game during 1960/61 and missed only three games last year through injury.

**KEN McPHERSON** (*Centre-half.*) Signed from Newport County in August, 1961, he is a player with a reputation for hard work. Originally a centre-forward he has proved he has the ability to take over in defence.

**BOB WOODRUFF** (*Wing-half.*) Another local born player who came to the town direct from the Swindon Schoolboys' team. Has played at centre-forward and inside-forward in the senior side and his performances have made him a target for several transfer offers.

**MIKE SUMMERBEE** (*Outside-right.*) Born in Cheltenham, he is another product of the Swindon Youth policy. Formerly played at centre-forward, but has now made the outside-right berth his own. Another of the players wanted by several clubs.

**ERNIE HUNT** (*Inside-right.*) Joined the Club's ground staff from school. A member of the First Team at 16 years old, he is a player of outstanding ability for whom the Club has had many offers. A local boy, he was top goal scorer 1960/61 and again last year.

**JACK SMITH** (*Centre-forward.*) Joined the Robins from Watford during the 1960/61 close season. He was formerly with Hartlepool United. A strong, forceful player with the ability to get the unexpected goal.

**CLIFF JACKSON** (*Inside-forward.*) Swindon born, he joined the club direct from school. He was a schoolboy international and he made his debut in Swindon's first team at the age of 17. Has a very powerful shot.

**ARNOLD DARCY** (*Outside-left.*) Joined the Club in November, 1956, from Wigan Athletic. In spite of his lack of inches he is a strong forceful winger with a powerful shot.

**WILFRED SHERGOLD** (*Outside-right or Centre-forward.*) Another product of the Swindon Youth policy. He is fast and can play in almost any position in the forward line.

**BILL ATKINS** (*Inside-forward.*) Joined Swindon from Aston Villa at the end of the 1958/59 Season. A strong ball playing forward. He played several representative matches while in the Army. Was demobbed mid-way through last season and quickly made the inside-left position his own.

**PETER CHAMBERLAIN** (*Half-back.*) A utility player who has been with the Club for four years. Was signed originally from Leicester City. Scored five goals in one game from the left-half position.





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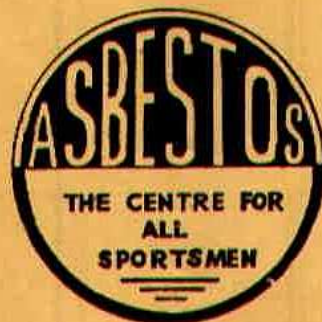

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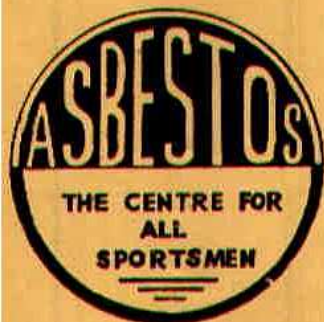

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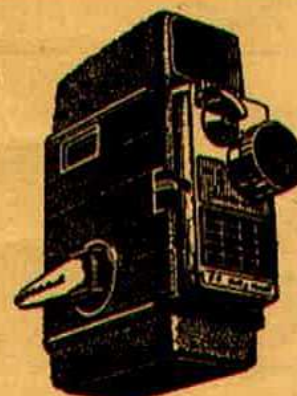
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
