

Later in the afternoon we again made news when Eamonn Andrews interviewed our Manager by direct line from the Centre Stand.

The whole of the Sport in the West programme at 6.25 p.m. was carried out from the County Ground.

In fact our ground was quite the centre of the B.B.C. activities.

We are also being visited by scores of press reporters. Some are helpful, some can be a nuisance.

Naturally press men have a job to do giving the public a true picture of events. We didn't altogether enjoy being referred to as the team with the "little wooden hutted ground".

One vital factor in all this publicity, one which can be lost sight of, is the fact it does not help the players. "Write-ups" often impose a strain and a tension on the team. They have a reputation to live up to. However, we feel our lads are young enough and resilient enough to take all in this in their stride, and get down to business. One thing we can be sure of is they will fight to the very end, and they never know when they are beaten.

The game against Rotherham was not quite up to the standard of the two previous home games. The wet, greasy ball seemed to shoot off the pitch very quickly at times and unsettle both teams. Consequently play was occasionally a little ragged. We did however see four well-planned and well-taken goals. Rotherham's goal and our second were both the result of real academic football.

The gate, the third highest in Division II, was very good, yet two thousand below the figure for last Tuesday. Strange,

On Saturday our lads, on entering the field of play, received a resounding cheer. Rotherham followed to a mild form of booing. Can we also say one final word about the officials (Referee and Linesmen). Theirs is a most difficult task, especially with capacity gates, and the game played at the speed it is today. Surely they need help and encouragement. On Saturday last we thought all three excellent. The referee controlled what could have been a difficult game splendidly. He was right on the spot and gave every decision without hesitation. The players realised he was the "boss", no arguments or incidents. Yet he was subjected to several outbursts of booing.






