

CLUB NOTES

Our Visitors today Swindon Town have got off to a start in the 2nd Division which has surprised everyone, including probably themselves. They head the Division with 19 points from 12 games having lost only one game, a remarkable achievement with a largely home produced eleven.

Surprisingly enough, the game they have lost was against Northampton Town, who

were promoted with them at the end of last Season.

Swindon Town though a comparatively young team cannot be termed inexperienced as most of their team have played together for the past four or five years. Decisive points are at stake today at Deepdale and we hope that todays game will be worthy of two teams occupying First and Fourth positions in the Second Division.

Following our lapse at Norwich, the Team regained its away effectiveness with a 2-1 win at Derby, a ground where we have not done too well in the past. Our nine points and sixteen goals to date from seven matches, equals our return from the whole of last Seasons Twenty-One away games. Similar consistency at home would put the Team in a strong position.

Alan Kelly has again been honoured by The F.A. of Ireland for the return European Nations Cup Tie with Austria in Eire on Sunday next. He missed the League Match at Derby through injury, but the two deputy goalkeepers, John Barton in the First Team and Gerry Stewart in the Second Team did remarkably well. This is one posi-

tion for which we have excellent cover.

Since our last issue Brian Godfrey has been signed from Scunthorpe United. Brian can play in most forward positions and will provide much needed cover for the forward line.

The First Team visit Maine Road on the 19th October, and Reserved seats are bookable in advance at 7/- and 9/- on application to the Manchester City Ground.





PEN PICTURES

- MIKE TURNER (Goal-Keeper) Just demobbed from the R.A.F. he joined the Club whilst still in the services from Dorchester Town. Took over in goal following the injury to O'Hara last season and is expected to make strong bids for the first team position this season.
- TERRY WOLLEN (Right Back). Another local boy made his debut for the First Team when 16 years old. He played the majority of first team games during Season 1960-61 and last season. Out with injury during the latter half of the season.
- OWEN DAWSON (Full back or Centre Forward) Signed during the close season from Portsmouth, Was a former Youth International and is expected to challenge for first-team honours this season.
- JOHN TROLLOPE (Left Back). A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the Season 1960-61, when he was 16 years old and was ever present during that season and last season. Maximum appearances in the League side during 1962-63.
- KEITH MORGAN (Right Half) Team Captain. A strong, attacking wing-half, who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Played in every first team game during 1960-61 season and missed only three games last year through injury. Made maximum appearances during 1962-63.
- KEN McPHERSON (Centre Half). Signed from Newport County in August, 1961, he is a player with a reputation for hard work. Originally a centre-forward he has proved he has the ability to take over in defence.
- ROGER SMART (Wing Half) Another local born player who joined the club direct from the Swindon schoolboy's team. At 17 he made the Centre-forward berth in the Reserve team his own. More recently converted to a wing half, he made four first-team appearances last season.
- BOB WOODRUFF (Wing Half). Another local born player who came to the town direct from the Swindon Schoolboy's team. Has played at centre-forward and inside-forward in the senior side and his performances have made him a target for several transfer offers.
- GRAHAM FRENCH (Lelf Wing) Close season signing from Shrewsbury Town. Gained his Youth International Cap for the very successful England Youth side last Season. He is a fast, elusive player. Age 18. Height 5' 10".
- MIKE SUMMERBEE (Outside Right). Born in Cheltenham, he is another product of the Swindon Youth policy. Formerly played at Centre-forward, but has now made the outside-right berth his own. Another of the players wanted by several clubs.
- BILL ATKINS (Inside Forward). Joined Swindon from Aston Villa at the end of the 1958-59 Season. A strong ball playing forward. He played several representative matches while in the Army. Was demobbed mid-way through last season and quickly made the inside-left position his own.
- ERNIE HUNT (Inside Right). Joined the Club's ground staff from school. A member of the First Team at 16 years old, he is a player of outstanding ability for whom the Club has had many offers. A local boy, he was top goal-scorer 1960-61 and 1961-62. Capped for England Under 23's during 1962-63.
- JACK SMITH (Centre Forward) Joined the Robins from Watford during the 1960-61 Season. He was formerly with Hartlepools United. A strong, forceful player with the ability to get the unexpected goal.
