

TWO MINUTES FROM GROUND

The draw for the 1st Round of the Football League Cup was published last week. Once again we regret the non-participation of some of the teams from Division I. Such is the pity. While this competition may not have been the attraction the officials hoped, it has certainly aroused interest, especially so in our club. The stirring games against Chelsea and West Ham United will long be remembered. With the addition of the ten defaulting clubs, the competition would, of course, be much better.

Whilst some of these clubs may have other commitments (European Cup, etc.), it does seem rather a selfish attitude on their part. After all, this competition does help the lesser clubs, and a home tie against a Division I team arouses tremendous interest especially to teams in Divisions III and IV.

RONNIE ALLEN (Forward)

Played 5 times for England and also figured in several representative matches. He holds an F.A. Cup Winner's medal, won with W.B.A. in 1954, and a 1st Division runners-up medal. He has made over 500 League appearances and has scored over 300 goals. Transferred to Palace in 1961 from W.B.A. Now a player-coach and doing much good work with the Club's youngsters.

CLIFF HOLTON (Forward)

Another of Soccer's great personalities. Played for Arsenal for 11 years and appeared at Wembley in the Cup Final, when Arsenal were reduced to 10 men, in 1952. Helped Watford to promotion from Division 4 in 1958 and then moved to Northampton in 1961 and soon became top scorer. Transferred to Palace in December 1962 and last season was top scorer for Palace. Cliff has made over 500 League appearances and has scored nearly 300 goals.

DON TOWNSEND (Defender)

Transferred to the Palace in 1962 after spending 12 years with Charlton. He is a loyal and complete footballer. Made 37 First Team appearances last season and in all has made over 350 League and Cup appearances.

EDDIE WERGE (Forward)

Represented London Youths and Kent Schools. Was 6 years with Charlton before joining Palace in 1961. Made 22 First Eleven appearances last season and can play equally well at I.F. or O.R.

PETER BURRIDGE (Forward)

Top goalscorer for Millwall for two seasons and was then transferred to Palace in 1962. He immediately became top scorer for his new club, until last season, when he was only just pipped at the post by Cliff Holton.

Made over 70 appearances during his 3-year stay with the "Canaries", then a further move, this time to Wrexham, where he was again a regular member of a promotion side when Wrexham moved into the 3rd Division. Transferred from Wrexham to Palace in November 1963 and once again helped his club to promotion, making 20 appearances.



The mention of the Office brings us to a project on which representatives of our Club have recently had meetings with the Directorate of the Football Club, and on which there have been references in the local Press from time to time.

Compared with some Supporters' Clubs, our social activities have been restricted in the past, owing to inadequate accommodation, and the Office also is not all that we would wish for the purpose of holding meetings, collection of subscriptions, the issue of tickets, and the conduct of other business matters.

However, it seems likely now that this state of affairs may be remedied in the comparatively near future, and that a building will be erected at the ground which will enable us, not only to deal with the business matters more efficiently, but also to greatly increase the social activities of the Club.
