

Once we were in a desperate position with Dietmar Bruck injured and a goal down, we performed under crippling circumstances much more like a Sky Blue team.

Although no team in the world can cope with continued injuries to key players and still get results, there were features about Saturday's match that gave me some encouragement.

For instance, there were signs that the forward line which had such a run of success at the start of last season might be in operation again in the near future. Willie Humphries returning to the side showed renewed zest for making Saturday afternoons a nightmare for full-backs, Ernie Machin increasing in confidence in every game following his injury is beginning to link harmoniously with fellow Lancastrian, George Hudson, once more. George, himself, rounded off an excellent bit of football to take our first goal in confident style and despite the hypnotic effect of the scoreboard, I think this will be the fore-runner of a few more. If you add to this the return of Ronnie Rees from International duty and Ken Hale from his knock on the thigh, I think you can see a pattern emerging

which I am sure will steadily lift us up the table. Injuries to Brian Hill, John Sillett and Dietmar Bruck have made the defensive problems more acute, but I am quite sure that when these players are back to fitness, we shall be able to give you something to cheer and sing about.

There were other features in last Saturday's game about which I was not as happy, but quite obviously it would not be fair to mention them publicly, but you can rest assured that time has been spent in the past week trying to eliminate faults.

We are publicly advised that the only way to future success is to buy half the players available in England. Even if we were able to afford it, there would still be the problem of welding them into a team, and it is team work that wins Divisions, not necessarily big names in newspaper headlines.

# Our Visitors today

This afternoon it gives us great pleasure to welcome once again the Officials, Players and Supporters of SWINDON TOWN to Highfield Road. The Club was founded in 1881 by the Rev. W. Pitt for the young men of his parish. Became a professional club in 1894 and played in the Southern League between 1894 and 1920. The year 1920 saw them become one of the original members of the League Division Three. Had never been out of the Third Division until they were promoted at the end of the 1962-63 season. With their very young side they made a tremendous start to the 1963-64 campaign but unfortunately were unable to sustain their efforts throughout the season. Popularly known as 'The Robins', the Club plays at the County Ground, which has a record attendance of 28,582 for a Cup match in February, 1964.

At present they are managed by Mr. Bert Head, an ex-Torquay and Bury player. He has concentrated on producing young players and his efforts are now beginning to bear fruit. His youth policy has gained him a reputation in the footballing fraternity, and it is to be hoped that it will continue to do so.

## PEN PICTURES

**NORMAN OAKLEY** (Goalkeeper) Born Norton-on-Tees. Joined Swindon from Hartlepool United in March, 1964.

**OWEN DAWSON** (R.B.) Born Hatfield. Signed from Portsmouth June, 1962. Was a former Youth International.

**JOHN TROLLOPE** (L.B.) Born Swindon. A local boy who joined the Swindon ground staff from school. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the season 1960/61 when he was 16 years old, and was ever present during that season and season 1961/62. Maximum appearances in the League side during 1962/63/64.

**KEITH MORGAN** (R.H.) Born Trowbridge. Team Captain. (A strong attacking wing-half, who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Made maximum appearances during 1962/3/4.

**KEN McPHERSON** (C.H.) Born West Hartlepool. Signed from Newport County in August, 1961, he is a player with a reputation for hard work. Originally a centre-forward he has proved he has the ability to take over in defence.

**ROGER SMART** (L.H.) Born Swindon. Another local born player who joined the Swindon club direct from the Swindon schoolboys' team. At 17 he made the centre-forward berth in the Reserve team his own, later converted to a wing-half.

**PETER LEGGETT** (O.R.) Born Newton-le-Willows. Signed from Weymouth May, 1962. He is a fast powerful player who can play in any position in the forward line.

**ERNIE HUNT** (I.R.) Born Swindon. Joined the Swindon ground staff from school. A member of the first team at 16 years of age, he is a player of outstanding ability, for whom the Swindon club has had many offers. A local boy, he was top goal-scorer 1960/61 and 1961/62. Capped for England Under-23's during 1962/63.

**MIKE SUMMERBEE** (C.F.) Born Cheltenham. He is another product of the Swindon Youth policy. Formerly played at Outside Right, but has now made the Centre Forward berth his own.

**KENNY SKEEN** (I.L.) A recent signing from Trowbridge Town, who made his debut for the Swindon club in the away match against Crystal Palace in the early part of the season.

**DONALD ROGERS** (O.L.) Born Paulton. A much sought after player. An England Youth player who it seems is destined for further honours.
