CLUB NOTES

To date Swindon have played 13 games, with the rather strange record of 4 wins, 4 draws, and 5 defeats, 13 goals for,

and 13 goals against.

The scoring of goals seems to be the problem, especially at home, where only 4 have been scored in 5 games, and all of those in one match. Strange as it may seem, the team is playing attacking football, as against the purely defensive policy adopted at times last season. The last two games played have produced identical results, 0—1, and yet very early in the season we had gained more away points than during the whole of last year. Can the tide turn and we witness a repetition of the Bristol Rovers game? Our supporters have been extremely loyal. Against Gillingham the attendance was over thirteen thousand, by far the highest in Division 3, and bigger than six gates in Division 2. We are very fortunate, but nevertheless our spectators, whilst appreciating good football, naturally want to see some goals scored, and enjoy the pleasure of home wins.

We know this lack of goal scoring is worrying the management, and everything is being done to improve the position, but the final say rests with the players. Just that last bit of determination and fight will bring the desired result. How often have we seen goals just missed because a player is casual, or the effort not just enough.

CLUB NOTES—continued

Our opponents this afternoon made a very quick rise to success, from non-league to Division 3 in a very short time. Perhaps like some other clubs (for instance Ipswich, Charlton and ourselves) that upward move was too rapid. We well remember Season 1962/63 when they almost gained promotion to Division 2.

Now however Peterborough seem to be consolidating the position, and at present are in sixth position. They have played 12 games, won 6, drawn 3, lost 3, with 15 points. They have scored 24 goals, with 18 against.

Today's game should therefore produce open football, with goals scored by both teams.

The last time we met was at Easter 1963, when the teams were striving to gain promotion. On Good Friday, Peterborough came to Swindon and won 3—2 before a record crowd of 23,239 spectators (I wonder if the gate will equal half of that number). When we lost 1—3 at Peterborough it looked as if our chances of promotion had disappeared but, as supporters well know, we finally finished in second position.

Swindon's team on the Good Friday was Turner; Huxford, Trollope; Morgan, McPherson, Woodruffe; Summerbee, Hunt, Stevens, Smith, Jackson. How the composition of teams change, as in all probability only two of that number will wear the red shirt this afternoon. Peterborough was represented by Ronson; Singleton, Sissons; Rayner, Hopkins, Simpson; Day, Moulden, Turly, Horobin, McNamee.

Swindon's team on the Easter Monday showed three changes: Owen, right back; Harber, left half; and Weaver, outside left.
