TWO MINUTES FROM GROUND

In the Swindon team Macpherson replaced Owen, and in the Reading team Wheeler played at outside-right and Maughan inside-right. In the return game at Reading, played in March, Swindon won by two goals to one.

We trust we shall enjoy an afternoon's entertainment with the meeting of old rivals, but friends.

Reading the sports columns of the National Press, one wonders just where football is going. It is certain that when the maximum wage was removed, neither the Players' Union nor the Football Association visualized the demands to be made for a signing-on fee. We hear of a player demanding a fee of £7,500 plus a weekly wage of £75. Supposing the player gives five years' good service (that can be doubtful) we reckon with bonuses, etc. he will be paid something like £7,000 per year. Surely we have our sense of values all wrong. Many of the best brains in the country — eminent surgeons, and even responsible men in the Cabinet — do not receive anything like that figure.

Just how can it be justified? Certainly not by the attendance at matches. The number of spectators get smaller every year. Last Saturday's figures showed that in Division 3 two games were played before less than 4,000, and only three games in the Division produced over 10,000 spectators.

The way things are going, some hard thinking and talking will have to take place, otherwise many of the smaller clubs will close down and we shall be left with a nucleus in the large centres of population. It is certainly a sign of the times when a well-known manager of quite a prosperous club stated categorically: "Should the Small Lotteries Act suddenly be brought to an end, 75% of the clubs would go out of football."
