CLUB NOTES

This afternoon we begin once again the excitement and glamour of the Cup Competition. For the past two seasons, by virtue of being members of Division 2, Swindon has been excused until the Third Round Proper of the competition.

This season we start in Round I. Our opponents will be well known to many of our older supporters, with their green and red shirts.

Merthyr Tydfil, as they were originally known, played in the Southern League from 1912-20, and then became one of the original members of League Division III in 1920-21.

This became Division III, and Merthyr remained members until 1930, when they failed to gain re-election. They finished in the bottom position and were replaced by a newly-formed club, Thames, whose spell in league football was very short indeed, just two seasons to be exact, as when they occupied last place at the end of 1931-32, Thames did not seek re-election and became defunct.

During their spell in Division III, Merthyr enjoyed a fair measure of success, but never reached a position higher than eighth. Their biggest score in league football was against Swindon (8—2) in Season 1927-28. Well known players who represented the club were Albert Sindon — goalkeeper (still a frequent visitor to the County Ground in the capacity of a scout), M. Russell, R. Williams and S. Gibbons.

CLUB NOTES—continued

Merthyr has a well-equipped ground (with floodlights) at Penydarren Park, capable of accommodating 25,000 spectators. They play in the First Division of the Southern League and are in 4th position, with 19 points from 13 games. A good record, especially as Barnet is top with 24 points from 16 games.

Last Saturday they defeated Dunstable by 2—1 before 1,540 spectators, an attendance somewhat below their average for the season. The previous week they won 2—1 at Wisbech. They will prove strong opponents.

The present team is composed mainly of players with league experience. The best known to our supporters will probably be Graham Vearncombe, remembered for his fine displays in goal for Cardiff City; Ken Tucker, right back, played for Cardiff, Northampton and Shrewsbury; Les Harris, left back, Swansea Town; Johnny Williams, right half, Torquay; Billy Herrity, Newport County; Reg Davies, Newcastle, Swansea, Southend and Carlisle; Harry Griffiths, inside right, is the player manager; Brian Jenkins, centre forward, Cardiff, Exeter and Bristol Rovers; Dudley Price, inside left, Swansea and Bradford City; Billy Rees, outside left, Swansea.

Certainly a team of talent and experience.

Last Saturday we had the pleasure of welcoming Reading to the County Ground, and the gaining of a resounding victory of 5 goals to nil. We cannot complain about the scarcity of goals at home.

Whilst we deserved our victory, especially by our play in the second half, we feel Reading were somewhat unfortunate. In the first half we thought they were the better team, and they could have gone in at half-time leading.

However, if easy chances are missed, the penalty is paid. Not that we took all our scoring chances. We are still creating them without making the final completion.

The Reading party were very disappointed with the display, but we thought from the spectators' point of view (especially the home ones) it was a fine game to watch. Fast, open football, little upset or gamesmanship. The game moved extremely quickly from end to end.

Such matches will bring in the supporters, and here again Swindon is most fortunate. Our gate was 15,627, the largest in our Division, even almost double some present at other games, e.g., Bristol Rovers (8,422). Even in Division 2, few gates were bigger than that at Swindon.

We frequently hear and read comments regarding the difference in the class of the football between the various divisions. One of our players seems to think Division 3 football is slower and harder than Division 2.

Based on our games this season, we feel we have seen more open, attacking football, less kicking away of the ball, less waste-of-time tactics and certainly not slower football. Gone for good, we hope, is the accent on defensive football.

Maybe fitness could have an effect on the apparent slowness of the opposition. Our spectators will certainly be happy if they can witness games such as those against Bristol Rovers, York City, Peterborough and Reading.

Highlights of today's game will be televised on TWW (West) on Sunday afternoon.


Signed professional 1964/65. Clever forward. Can play inside or outside left. Dangerous in front of goal.






