SO the team is out of the F.A. Cup at last after a run that has seen them reach the fourth round, the first time they have reached this milestone for many years.

But before they made their exit from this year's competition they earned for themselves the title of the day's unluckiest team.

Up until six minutes from the end they were leading 2-1 and looking like repeating their feat of the previous round when they beat a team from a higher division on their own ground.

But it was not to be. Norwich snatched an equaliser and two minutes from the end robbed Walsall of a second chance by taking the lead for the first time in the match.

Nevertheless the team have given a heartening show in the competition considering that they met teams from each division of the Football League, three of them away from home, before they finally said goodbye to any further interest.

The previous week the club made history when they flew to an away match, the first time they had flown, as a club.

The venue on this occasion was Southend and although the team lost 5-3 there was no doubt that the speed and convenience of air travel was a boon to all, whose job it is to travel for these away fixtures.

Now that interest in the F.A. Cup has gone the club must concentrate on improving their league position and this is where you can all help. You have helped magnificently in the past and a repeat of this sort of support will not only encourage the team but it will encourage the management to increase their efforts on your behalf.

Pen Pictures of SWINDON TOWN F.C.

Goalkeeper :

PETER DOWNSBOROUGH. Signed at the commencement of the season from Halifax Town where he was a product of local football. Has done much to strengthen the Town's defence.

Full-backs :

OWEN DAWSON. Signed from Portsmouth June, 1962. Was a former Youth International.

JOHN TROLLOPE. Was selected for the First Team at the beginning of the season 1960/61 when he was 16 years old, and was ever present during that season and season 1961/62.

Half-backs :

KEITH MORGAN. A strong attacking wing-half, who joined Swindon as a youth player from Westbury. Made maximum appearances during 1962/3/4.

MEL NURSE. A recent signing from Middlesborough. He needs little introduction to football followers. A strong forceful player. He has many Welsh International caps to his credit.

ROGER SMART. Another local born player who joined the Club direct from the Swindon Schoolboy's team. At 17 he made the centre-forward berth in the Reserve team his own later converted to a wing-half.

Forwards :

KEITH EAST. He scored 20 goals in 26 games for the Club's Reserve Team which gained promotion to Division I of the Football Combination last season.

DONALD ROGERS. A much sought after player. An England youth player who it seems is destined for further honours.

ERIC WEAVER. He joined Swindon as a professional in August, 1965. A useful player in most positions in the forward line.
