This afternoon we entertain old friends, Southend United. Like us, they played in the Southern League, and became founder members of Division 3 (South). We last played them in November 1962 and April 1963.

The home game in November resulted in a win for Swindon by 4 goals to 1. Our team was Turner; Wollen, Trollope; Morgan, McPherson, Woodruff; Summerbee, Hunt, Smith, Jackson, Rogers; the last-named coming in as a late replacement for Arnold Darcy (injured). This was Donald's first appearance of the season in the senior team. It is interesting to note that in this, the promotion year, Rogers played seven times in Division III games.

The return match, played in April, resulted in a 1-1 draw. Both teams were fighting for promotion, although our position was little higher than that of Southend. Owen Dawson was injured, and left the field early, and we were reduced to ten players, virtually for the whole of the game. Mike Summerbee went to right-back, and Mick Turner played a great game in goal. Swindon's team: Turner; Dawson, Trollope; Morgan, McPherson, Woodruff; Summerbee, Hunt, Stevens, Smith, Jackson.

Older supporters will remember "Tober" Weston, a great left-back and stalwart of the 1920's and early 30's. Recently he entered hospital, and it was feared he would lose a leg. At first the trouble responded to treatment, and hopes were high that no amputation would be necessary.

NOTICE

to

PLAYERS, OFFICIALS AND SPECTATORS

(Extract from Rules)

Players, Officials and Spectators are only allowed to take part in or attend matches on condition that they observe the Rules of the Association, and every affiliated Association or Club is required to observe and enforce such rules.

Every Association or Club is responsible to the Council for the action of its Players, Officials and Spectators, and is required to take all precautions necessary to prevent Spectators threatening or assaulting Officials and Players, during or at the conclusion of Matches. An Official of an Association or Club, Referee, Linesman, or Player, shall not bet on any Football Match, and Association and Clubs are also required to prevent betting and the use of objectionable language by Spectators. In the case of a breach of this Rule, any Player, Official, or Spectator may be removed from any ground, and such force used as may be necessary for the purpose of effecting such removal.

The Association shall be entitled to publish in the public Press, or in any other manner it shall think fit, reports of its proceedings, acts and resolutions whether the same shall or shall not reflect on the character or conduct of any Club, Official, Player, or Spectator, and every such Club, Official, Player, or Spectator shall be deemed to have assented to such publication.

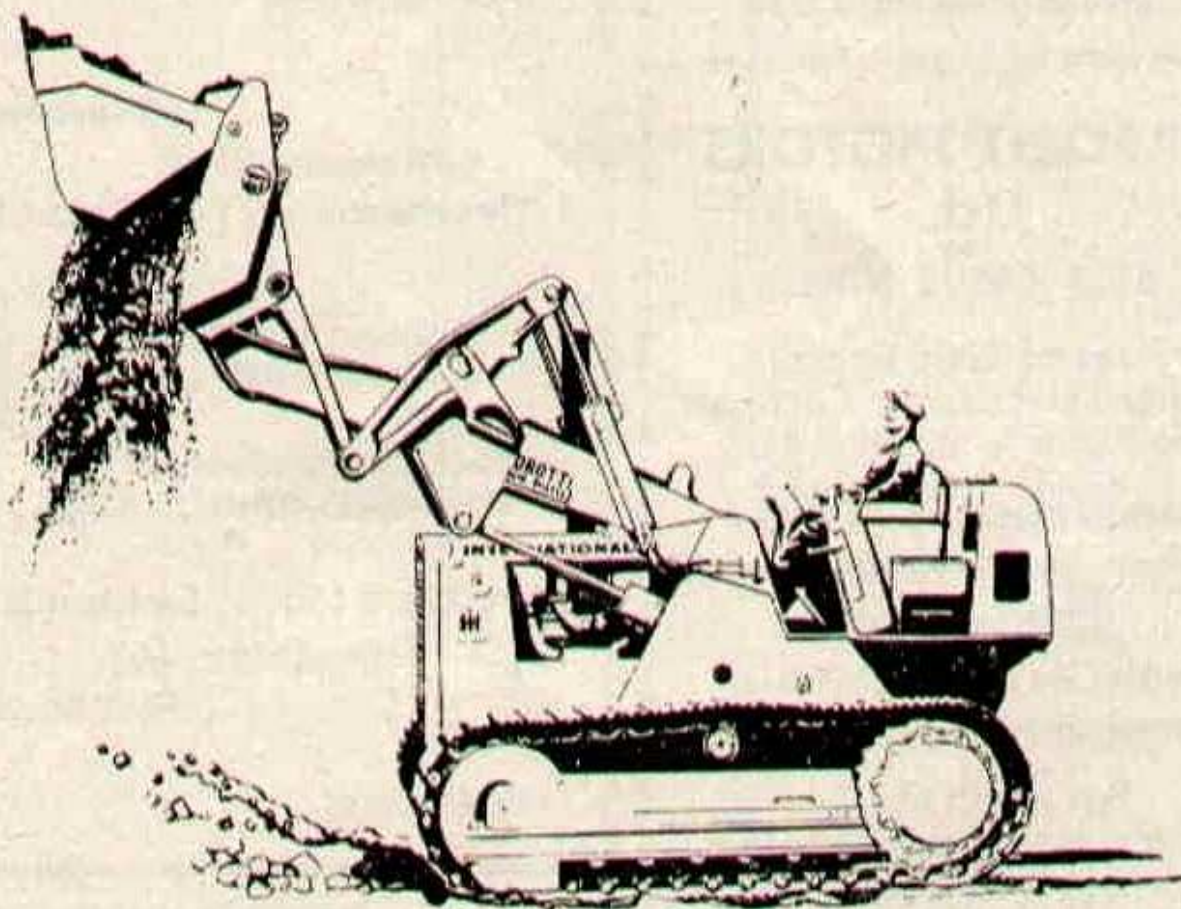

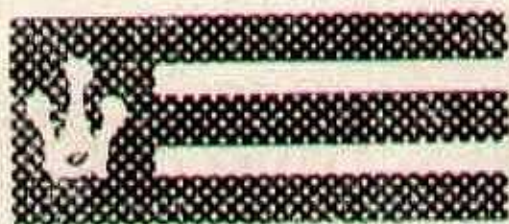
