## **CLUB NOTES**

Mr. Howell, M.P., Minister with special responsibility for sport, in a recent statement, deplored the lack of use made of football stadiums except for the very short period each year that they are operating for their main purpose.

This is a fact which we have frequently high-lighted in these notes. There is a great tendency to divide the overheads of a Football Club by 52 and base on an average weekly overhead, whereas in fact the income earning period of any club will average little more than 35 hours per annum. When overheads are calculated on this basis the cost per hour assumes frightening proportions.

By their general lay-out football grounds are restricted in alternative uses, and the obvious alternative of greyhound racing, which was tried by a number of clubs, is now banned by higher authority.

At Ayresome Park we have made the best possible use of our stands by installing a thriving social club, but the problem of how to create income from stands, seating and playing areas remains unsolved for the 340 or more days when league football is not being played.

We are sure that everybody in Middlesbrough Football Club would be prepared to co-operate with the Minister if he could submit some clear and tangible scheme.

We would like to extend a hearty welcome to our latest acquisition from Falkirk, Willie Whigham. Willie, a 6ft. 2 inch Goalkeeper, has been showing excellent form with Falkirk and by all accounts is being considered for representative honours with the Scottish team. We sincerely hope that his stay at Ayresome Park is a long and successful one.

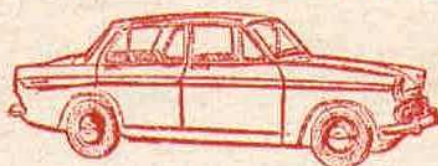

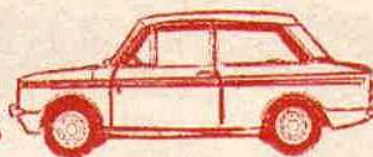

## IT'S GOALS THAT COUNT

Analyse all your plans, argue over what might have been, curse the ref. if you wish . . . ultimately it's goals that count in this game. Though history proves a good defensive side will generally win more honours than an outstanding attacking team, it's still the men who hit the goals who find themselves surrounded in glory.

Including last Saturday, 371 goals had been scored in Division III: 232 by home sides, 139 by visitors. Queen's Park Rangers are top scorers with 35, Leyton Orient have hit fewest. They had managed only 8.

Bristol Rovers have the longest scorers' list. Ten of their men have found the target. Smallest list belongs to neighbours Darlington for whom only Bobby Cummings, Les O'Neill and John Peverell (a full back!) have netted. Rodney Marsh (11 League goals, plus 5 in the League Cup) is easily the best individual scorer. Scunthorpe's top scorers have only two goals each — Barry Thomas, Michael Ash, Barry Lindsey, Frank Barton and Bob Smith are all level.

While talking of low top scorers, it is worth recording that top scorer so far for Czechoslovakian First Division club VSS Kosice is their goalkeeper! Kosice have managed only 4 goals from their first 8 games and Svajlen has got two of them, both from penalties.

No players from Leyton Orient, Scunthorpe, Swansea, Walsall or Watford have scored more than once in the League yet. On the other hand Q.P.R., through Rodney Marsh, have registered three hat-tricks (2 Lge., 1 L.C.) and Grimsby have two — both in one game against Scunthorpe. Eight hat-tricks have been hit in Division III, against seven in Division II, six in Division I and three in Division IV.

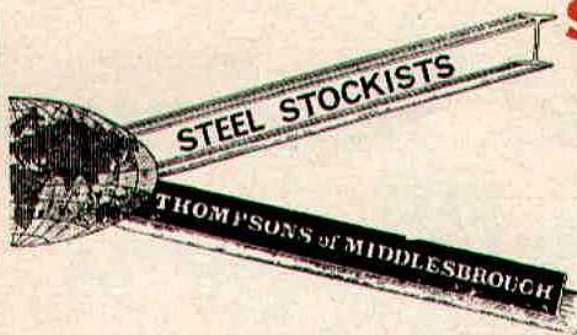

The complete list of Division III scorers to date includes 167 players; leading the way are: Marsh (Q.P.R.) 11; Stubbs (Torquay) 9; Allen (Q.P.R.) 8; Cummings (Darlington), Foley (Workington) and Kinnell (Oldham) 7 each; ARTHUR HORSFIELD (Middlesbrough), Fairbrother (Peterborough), Hill (Grimsby), Hodgson and Stratton (Colchester), Meredith (Shrewsbury) and Sheffield (Doncaster) 6 each.

Colchester are the only side to score in every League match. By far the most popular scores are 1-0, 2-1 and 1-1, each of which have occurred 14 times. It is interesting to study the scores thrown up, listed below in order of popularity:

From the above it will be seen that 67 games have resulted in home wins, 26 aways and 30 drawn. Each game has averaged approximately 3.02 goals whereas the average at Ayresome Park for four Division III games is 3.5.

The most number of consecutive matches in which any Third Division player has scored is five. Reg Stratton scored in all Colchester's opening five games and currently Rodney Marsh (Q.P.R.) has made a run of five games (including a League Cup tie it is six in a row). Arthur Horsfield, Ken Hodgson (Colchester) and Trevor Meredith (Shrewsbury) have all scored in four consecutive league games.

### **SWINDON BACKS MAGNIFICENT RECORD**

Barring accidents Swindon's left-back John Trollope will be making his 266th **consecutive** first-team appearance at Ayresome Park today. He was the only player in the country to complete the last five seasons without missing a League game.

Swindon's full back partnership of Trollope and Owen Dawson is one of the most consistent in the Football League. They have appeared together on almost 150 occasions. Dawson cost Swindon a mere £300 when he moved from Portsmouth in 1962. He never played in Portsmouth's League team.

It will be a nostalgic return to Ayresome for Welsh international centre-half Mel Nurse who left us at the beginning of last season because he wanted to live closer to his Welsh home. Mel made his League debut with Swansea in 1955, was selected for his country at Schoolboy, Youth and Under-23 levels before winning 12 full caps.

Two other Swindon men have tasted football in the north-east. Former Glasgow Rangers player Willie Penman made 62 appearances for Newcastle, scoring 18 goals, before moving south this year. And Joe Butler developed through Newcastle's junior sides. He went to Swindon in August 1965.

Goalkeeper Peter Downsborough joined the club last season. He made a name for himself at Halifax, where he entered League football in 1959/60. Keith Morgan, who is so well endowed with the best attacking and defensive qualities essential to the best in his position, joined the "Robins" from Westbury in 1958. Left-half Stan Harland arrived from Carlisle this close-season following a chequered career which started with his signing amateur forms for Burnley. But it was with New Brighton that he started his professional career, outside the League. He was signed by Everton but it was not until he moved again, this time to Bradford City, that his persistence paid off in the form of his League debut.

On the left wing is England Under-23 international—one of only a few Third Division men selected for this high honour—Don Rogers who hit 17 League goals last season. For a "country bumpkin" Don has certainly made the soccer world sit up. He recalls that when, as a 15-year-old, he made the journey from his Somerset home to sign for Swindon it was the first time he had travelled on a train!

Keith East is the centre-forward given away by Portsmouth. Last season he led the scorers with 19 League goals. In November he hit five past a startled Mansfield defence; he was one of only five players to reach that total in a first-class game last season. It was the more remarkable because in the previous game he hit four in a F.A. Cup-tie.

Wing-half or inside-forward Roger Smart has lost his regular place but is eagerly awaiting the chance to re-establish himself. Former Chelsea starlet Dennis Brown has played in several forward positions this season.

It hasn't been a happy season so far for Swindon, whom many thought would be among the chief challengers for promotion. They seem to have been afflicted by an amazing failing during the second-halves of their games. They were losing at the interval in only one of their first nine League games yet finished on the winning side only once and drew two others.

We have previously met on only four occasions, during Swindon's only two campaigns in Division II: 1963/64 and 1964/65. We drew 1—1 and won 4—1 here, lost 0—2 and won 1—0 at Swindon.
