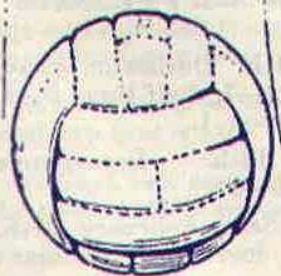

We welcome Swindon Town to the Gay Meadow this evening and are proud to acknowledge their feat in reaching the fifth round of the F.A. Cup and continuing the challenge our own Club have made for the Third Division in the past two seasons. This challenge is in no small way due to the efforts of Manager, Tony Williams, a former long serving Rotherham player, whose own personal example and determination to do well was always a feature of his game and is obviously rubbing off on his players.

Tony Hicks (Goalkeeper). Has only had one League Club, Swindon Town, and after being in the background for a long time this local born player is coming into his own. On the small side for a goalkeeper, but stockily built. 5 ft. 9 ins., weighs 11 st. 10 lbs.

Rod Thomas (Right Back). A Welsh lad from Glyncoirwg. He had experience with Southern League Club, Gloucester City, and is a regular. Stands 6 ft. 1 in., weighs 12 st.

John Trollop (Left Back). John has been a regular player in the Swindon side for several seasons, but is still in his early 20's. Local born and with no other Club. Stands 5 ft. 10 ins. and weighs 11 st.

Keith Morgan (Right Half). Born at Trowbridge, this six footer weighs 12 st. 8 lbs., has had no other League Club, and has been a stalwart for several seasons.

Mel Nurse (Centre Half). Swansea born and a Welsh International who joined Swindon from Middlesborough and also played with Swansea Town. Stands 6 ft. and weighs 12 st. 12 lbs.

Stan Harland (Left Half). Liverpool born. Completes a six foot half back line being 6 ft. 1 in. and 11 st. 12 lbs. Formerly with Carlisle and Bradford City.

Don Rogers (Outside Right). Probably the most sort after youngster in the game. Honoured by England as Youth and Under-23. Born at Paulton, Nr. Bristol, and a product of the Nursery. 5 ft. 10 ins. and 12 st. 6 lbs.

Willie Penman (Inside Right). After experience at Newcastle and Glasgow Rangers, this Fifeshire lad is doing well at Swindon. Stands 5 ft. 8½ ins., weighs 10 st. 2 lbs.

Ken Skeen (Centre Forward). A Cheltenham born player, formerly with Trowbridge. He stands 5 ft. 10 ins. and weighs 11 st. 3 lbs.

Roger Smart (Inside Left). Another local born player in his early 20's with several seasons experience. Stands 5 ft. 11 ins., weighs 11 st. 4 lbs.

Bobby Jones (Outside Left). A Bristol born player who joined recently from Bristol Rovers. 5 ft. 8½ ins., and 11 st. 12 lbs.

Joe Butler (Substitute). 5 ft. 7½ ins., 10 st., he is Newcastle born and was secured from Newcastle United.
