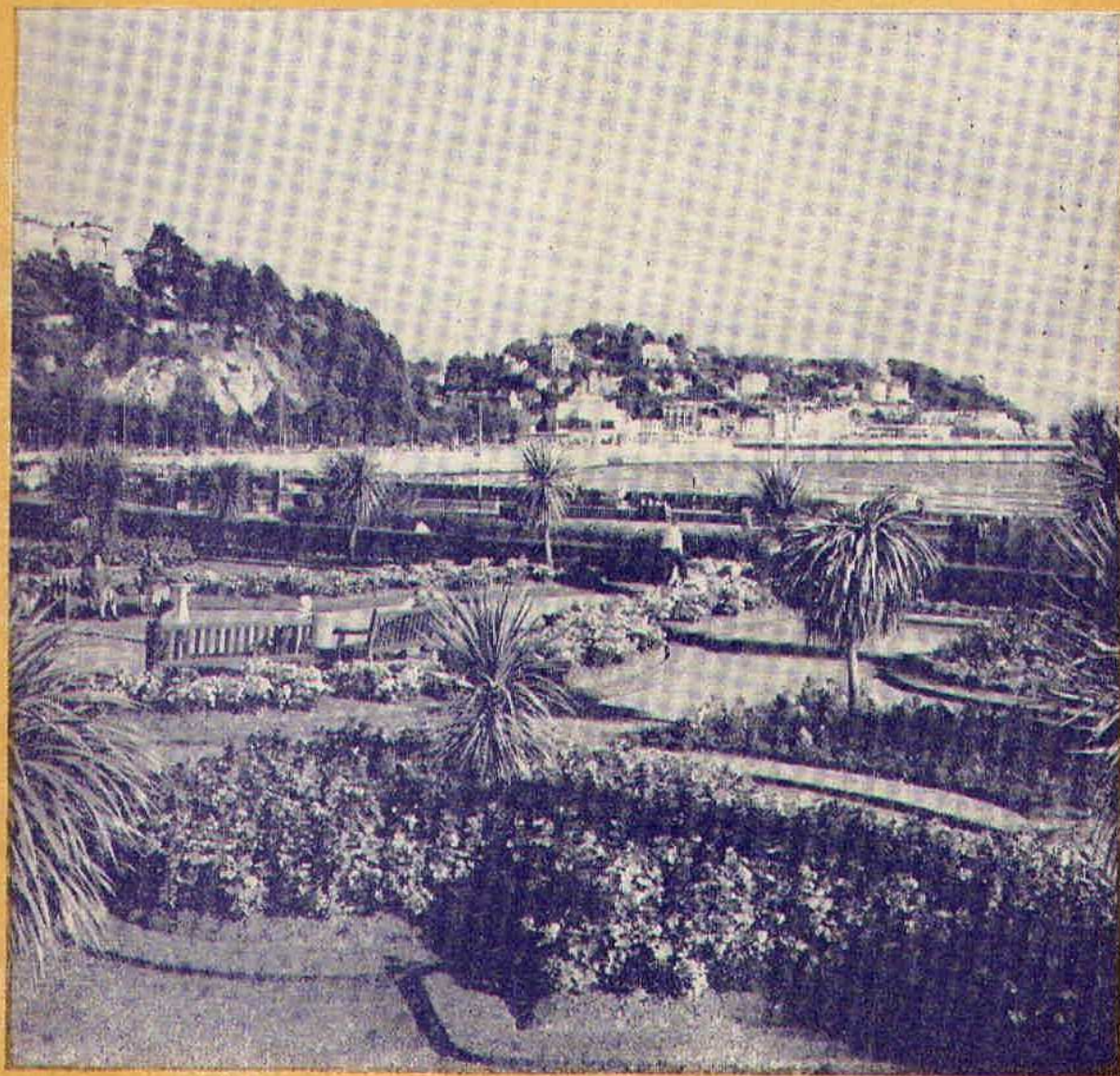

# Swindon have done the Third Division Proud

**H**ERE'S wishing all our friends at Plainmoor a happy Easter holiday. May today's football match give it the best possible start.

How about starting off with two special cheers. One for our own footballers, of course. And another for the men of Swindon to show them how much we appreciate their recent gallant achievements in the F.A. Cup competition. As Swindon are among our closest Third Division neighbours, with many links, past and present with Torquay United, we have followed their adventures with the closest interest and admiration. Their feats did the Third Division proud.

The Easter programme heralds the start of the last lap of the season. But an immense amount of football remains to be played and watched.

April, for instance, brings a total of seven Football League games for United, three of them at home, plus an intriguing friendly with Blackburn Rovers. The Western League side will be just as busy during the month ahead. While all this activity is being stage managed and controlled, Manager Frank O'Farrell will also, no doubt, be looking around for ways and means to strengthen the club's challenge next season.

One new player, centre half Ken Brown, from West Ham, is lined up already, and there will certainly be more. From the end of the season, also, there will be a good deal of development going on at Plainmoor to give the old place a face-lift before the start of the fresh campaign.

The supporters, too, are already hard at work planning summertime activities which will help bolster the finances of the Football Club.

The Paignton section of the Supporters' Club are in the throes of organising their annual Rag Day, which promises to be a really great day out this year. It is to be held in Victoria Park and among the highlights will be a cricket match, in the afternoon, between the Black and White Minstrels, who will be appearing at the Paignton Festival Hall this summer, and Max Bygraves and Company, from Torquay's Princess Theatre.

In the evening there will be a football match between women's teams and refereed by one of Plainmoor's best-known personalities. There will also be a very serious tug-of-war contest as well as various sideshows and possibly sporting demonstrations. For your diary, the Rag Day date is June 21st.

The Rag Day plans are just another example of the enthusiasm which abounds among the Plainmoor devotees, thanks to the inspiration from the top levels of the club.

Only eight months ago we were new boys in the Third Division, wondering what we would come up against and how we would get on. Dedicated leadership and an enthusiastic response by the players overcame the problems to such an extent that in recent weeks there has been talk among the fans of further progress this season. Whether that happens or not—and really it would be a lot to expect—we can be proud of the progress which has been made.

## OUR GUESTS . . .

ONE of the big puzzles of the season is how Swindon Town came to be struggling in the Third Division relegation zone when they are capable of extending First Division giants Nottingham Forest to three matches by dint of constructive, pleasing football after thrashing West Ham after two games.

Swindon say, with justification, that they are not able to flower their game in the League. Certainly, it would be a tragedy if such a fine side lost their status.

Manager Danny Williams has a judicious mixture of youth and experience. In goal is local boy **Tony Hicks**, who has taken over so capably following the cartilage injury to first choice Peter Downsborough.

Full backs are local boy **John Trollope** who made his debut at 16 and made his 250th consecutive appearance in December, and **Rod Thomas**, from Gloucester who has won Welsh Under 23 caps this season.

Wing halves are Westbury-born **Keith Morgan** and **Stan Harland**, who has been playing great football since he joined from Carlisle last October. Centre half is club captain **Mel Nurse**, the Welsh international who signed from Middlesbrough.

At outside right is **Don Rogers**, local born star who is the target of several First Division clubs. He is partnered by **Willie Penman**, clever ball playing Scot who was signed only last November from Newcastle. He was previously with Glasgow Rangers.

Centre forward is **Pat Terry**, signed from Reading only a few weeks ago and who did not take part in the Cup run. Also Cup-tied was left winger **Bobby Jones**, former Bristol Rovers stalwart, who was signed a few weeks ago after only three months at Northampton.

His partner is **Roger Smart**, yet another local boy who has made good, and who caught the eye in Town's exciting Cup run.

## GEOFF COX

ONE of Torquay's longest serving players, Geoff Cox, has not been Torquay's luckiest footballer in recent years. Cartilage trouble put him out of the game last season and, after six first team matches early in this campaign, he has been featuring in the Western League side.

His good work at wing half has been a big help to the younger Reserve footballers.

Recruited from Birmingham City over nine years ago, Geoff played on the wing in his early games for United but he was later converted to inside forward or wing half and gave splendid service in both positions—a thoroughly good club man.

Cox joined Birmingham City straight from school, signing as a full professional at the age of 17 after a short spell on the ground staff.

The same year he had 23 League games for Birmingham, playing on the right and left wings and at inside forward.

As a National Serviceman he had representative matches for the Army against Jersey and Guernsey in the Channel Islands and the Irish League, but when he returned to Birmingham he found that City, with established stars such as Gordon Astall and Alex Govan on the wings, could not offer him a regular first team place, and he moved to Plainmoor.
