EDITORIAL COMMENT

Manager David, Russell and his back-room boys must be wondering if there is no end to the plague of injuries that has beset Rovers over the past six weeks. Just when it seemed he had achieved a clean bill of health with the return to action of Mandy Hill, Johnny King and George Hudson, Stan Storton, Mandy and Gerry Casey suffered injuries in the match against Bristol Rovers and at the time of writing there is no way of telling which, if any, of them will be fit for tonight's game against Swindon Town. Most seriously injured is Stan Storton, who pulled a muscle early in the second half, and that injury almost certainly led to the loss of a point for Rovers' defence had shown themselves able to cope with the fast and clever Bristol attack. Joe Pritchard, tried gallantly to fill the gap, but full-back play is a specialist's job.

In the interval they have had a flirtation with Second Division football and brief though it was it served to inspire other Third Division escapists. Swindon are one of the few Third Division sides who get a call from Sir Alf Ramsey for a player for international duty. Don Rogers picked up the latest of his several England honours less than a fortnight ago.


