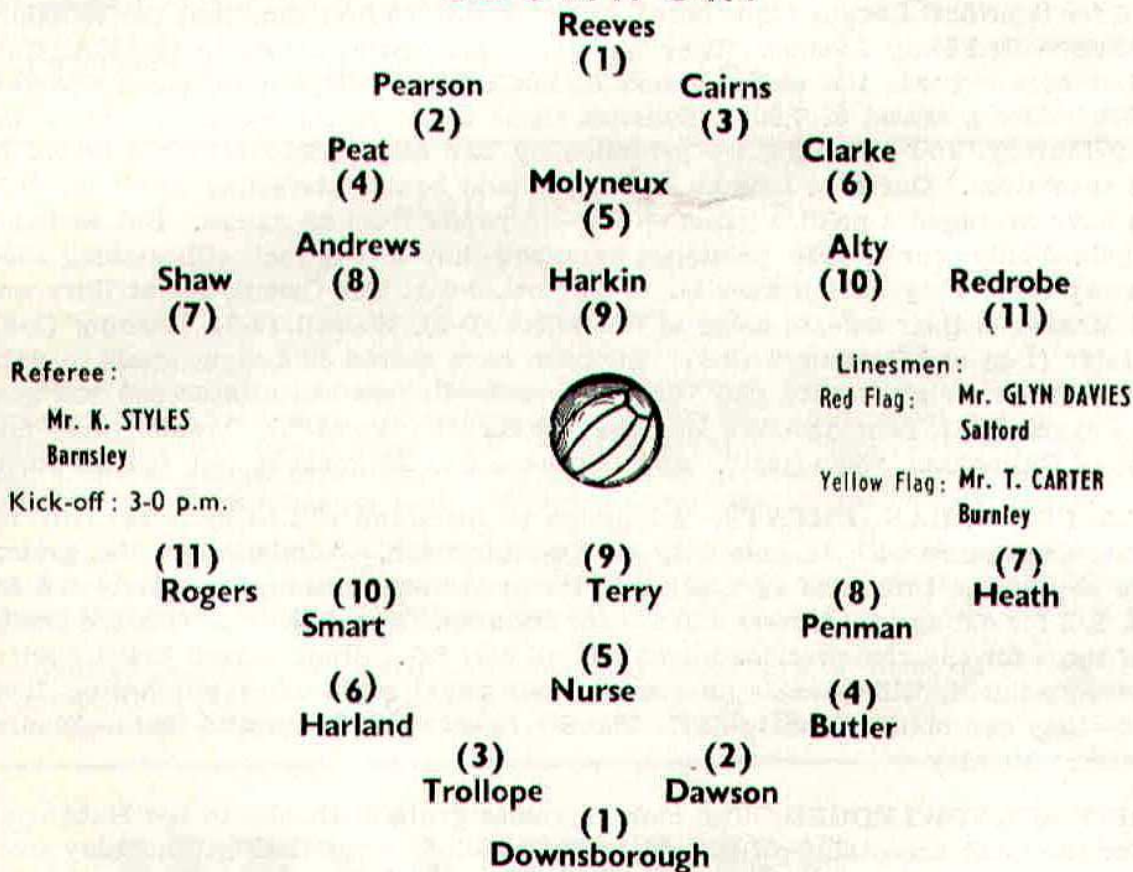

Club Notes

FIRST FOR 29 YEARS. This afternoon we welcome Swindon Town to our ground for their first League game here. But it is not the first time that the Wiltshire club have visited Haig Avenue. They have been here twice before in the F.A. Cup. The first occasion was the second round of the 1932-33 competition, when Swindon won 2-1 before a crowd of 7,900. Swindon came again in the second round of the 1938-39 tourney, and this time we prevailed by two clear goals before a crowd of 10,996 spectators. Our first League meeting should be an interesting affair, as both teams have averaged a point a game so far—18 points from 18 games. But Swindon have gained only four of their points on tour, and they are, in fact, still seeking their first away win. They have drawn 1-1 at Barrow, 0-0 at The Orient, 1-1 at Bury and 2-2 at Mansfield, their defeats being at Stockport (0-2), Walsall (2-3), Reading (1-2), Colchester (1-2) and Tranmere (2-3). Swindon have scored 32 League goals to date, their marksmen being Rogers and Terry (10 each—Rogers has also scored one goal in the League Cup), Penman (six), Harland and Smart (two each), Dawson (one) and Bailey, of Gillingham, "own goal". Swindon have had 22 goals scored against them.

F.A. CUP ARRANGEMENTS. Admission to the stand will be by ticket only for the F.A. Cup game with Lincoln City on December 9th. Admission to the ground will be pay at the turnstiles as usual, and the prices are unchanged, namely 4/6 for adults, 2/6 for old age pensioners and 2/- for children. Stand tickets, with the exception of those for the vice-presidents box, will all cost 8/-. Stand season ticket holders and vice-president, will be able to occupy their usual seats after purchasing their tickets—they can obtain them to-day. The 8/- tickets will be on sale to the general public from Monday.

How fortunes can change. Mansfield Town, who began the season with a 4-2 home win over Southport, took seven points from their first eight games, but have collected only two points from their last ten matches. They have not won any of their last five games before their own supporters at Field Mill, while they have lost their last seven matches on tour, the worst away run in the Third Division.

On the other hand, a revival has taken place at Oldham, the Athletic having won their last six games with a goal average of 12 for and two against. Reg Blore, the former Southport leader, now playing on the right wing, has scored one of those goals.

Walsall and Oxford United are two teams doing well at home at present. Both have won their last six home games. It is seven in the case of Oxford if you include their Football League cup win over Preston North End.

PETER DOWNSBOROUGH. Born Halifax. Signed in August, 1965, from Halifax Town, where he was a product of local football. A fearless agile player who has done much to strengthen the Town's defence. Height 5ft. 10½ in. Weight 12st. 5lb.

OWEN DAWSON. Born Hatfield. Signed from Portsmouth in June, 1962. A fast tenacious player. He was a former Youth International. Height 5ft. 10in. Weight 11st.

JOHN TROLLOPE. Born Swindon. Joined the ground staff from school. Was selected for the first team at the beginning of the 1960/61 season, when he was just 16 years old. Last season he celebrated 300 consecutive League appearances for the club. Height 5ft. 10in. Weight 11st.

JOE BUTLER. Born Newcastle. Signed from Newcastle United in August, 1965. A tenacious player whose speed and ability amply make up for his lack of inches. Height 5ft. 7 3-4 in. Weight 9st. 13lb.

MEL NURSE. Born Swansea. Signed from Middlesbrough in August, 1965. He played for Wales twelve times, gaining nine of his Caps while with Swansea Town before being transferred to Middlesbrough in September, 1962. Height 6ft. 0½ in. Weight 12st. 12lb.

STAN HARLAND. Born Liverpool. Signed from Carlisle United in July, 1966. Formerly with Everton and Bradford City. A forceful player who likes to go forward to back up the forwards in attack. Height 6ft. Weight 12st. 7lb.

BRUCE WALKER. Born Newbury. Joined Swindon from county football. Though he is not a big player, his ability and speed make him a menace to any defence. He has a particularly powerful shot. Height 5ft. 9in. Weight 11st.

WILLIE PENMAN. Born Wemyss, Fife. Signed from Newcastle United in September, 1966, for a considerable fee. Formerly with Glasgow Rangers. A clever ball-playing inside-forward. Height 5ft. 8in. Weight 11st. 7lb.

PAT TERRY. Born Lambeth. Signed last season from Reading, where he was the leading goal scorer. Prior to this he played for Charlton, Swansea, Gillingham, Northampton and Millwall. Height 5ft. 9½ in. Weight 12st. 6lb.

ROGER SMART. Born Swindon. Joined the club direct from Swindon schoolboys team. At 17 he was appearing regularly at centre-forward in the reserve team. A versatile player who is able to play at wing-half. Height 5ft. 11in. Weight 11st. 4lb.

DON ROGERS. Born Paulton. Probably the most sought after player in the team. Signed by Swindon when only 15, and quickly came to the fore.
