

# ARFON GRIFFITHS

What an incentive we have got tonight — a home tie against European and First Division champions Liverpool, or Coventry City. There will be no need to motivate players before tonight's game.

What we must not forget, of course, is that the same prize also goes for Swindon!

When the draw was made, it was obvious that with so many First Division sides involved we would bound to have a good tie — coming out of the hat first for a home tie, is a bonus.

Oddly enough, Mel Sutton and I went to see Liverpool and Coventry in the 4th round tie at Anfield last Tuesday. It was the nearest game and they were both still in the competition. It was ironic, and handy that we or Swindon should be drawn against them.

One thing I can say before tonight's result is known, whichever side goes on from this game will certainly not let the Third Division down.

Swindon have got a great record in the cup and remember, they have won the Football League trophy and what a fright they gave Everton last season in the F.A. Cup.

I said when the 4th round draw was made that Swindon would prove hard opposition for us. Knowing that they have a home game if they win will certainly add some spice into the match.

But we must not forget our own record in cup competitions.

Football is all about involvement and interest and we are still involved in FOUR competitions. The Third Division Championship, the F.A. Cup, the League Cup and the Welsh Cup. Promotion of course must take priority but there is no doubt about it that the fans like cup matches because it is a sudden death affair.

My job tonight will be to keep the lads in the right frame of mind without shouting and getting them too excited. There is always a bit

of a special atmosphere in the dressing room before a cup match — just like a top of the table League match.

We have been drawn away to Chester in the Welsh Cup and go back to Preston in the next round of the F.A. Cup. Both these games could not be harder, but we had good results at both grounds already this season and that is why we are thinking the games are going to be tough — so must Preston's Nobby Stiles and Chester's Alan Oakes!

You will see on the opposite page a sketch of what our new 'kop will look like when completed. I am all for ground improvements and I still believe despite some feeling in the game about having all seating at grounds, that there are a lot of fans who prefer to stand up at a game. It's a British way of life that will never change.

Our new 'kop will certainly bring back the atmosphere especially being covered. You think of all the grounds with the best atmospheres, Anfield, Old Trafford etc., they all have covered 'kops.

Gareth Davis will be launching his testimonial in the New Year and our idea to visit pubs and clubs to play regulars at darts, dominoes and pool, etc., has certainly proved a winner.

We have had so many inquiries already that I am not sure when we will get round to fixing up dates but we will have until next November and we will try our best to get to all these premises who have made inquiries. I must add that some have come from all over North Wales.

I think this idea is not only good for the testimonial fund, but also a good public relations exercise for us to meet the fans.

I sincerely believe that the fans, who pay part of our wages, and travel all over to see our games, should be more involved. I saw this at its best in America, and I hope that this is something which will catch on more in this country.

# FLASHBACK What The Papers Said

## 10 years ago—Nov. 1967

Wrexham gained a good point in a 1—1 draw at Notts County. **Don Weston** put Wrexham into the lead with a fine goal in the 35th-minute.

County came more into the picture in the second half and **John Elliot** equalised in the 79th-minute.

There was high drama in the closing minutes. **Steve Ingle** tripped **Eric Weaver** and County were awarded a spot kick. Before **Alec Gibson** could take it Wrexham trainer **John Neal** had to treat 'keeper **Gordon Livsey** — and when he did take the kick **Weaver** hit it wide.

Attendance 4,878.

## 15 years ago—Nov. 1962

Liverpool had their 'spies' in the 10,773 crowd who saw Wrexham beat Bristol City 2—1 at The Racecourse. Liverpool were to come to Wrexham in the F.A. Cup.

It was **Alan Fox's** 300th game for Wrexham. **Brian Whitehouse** and **Ernie Phythian** were the Wrexham marksmen.

Wrexham's **Arfon Griffiths** and **Tecwyn Jones**, along with Everton's **Colin Green** and Bolton's **Wyn Davies** were named in Wales under-23 squad to play Scotland.

## 20 years ago—Nov. 1957

Barrow 2 Wrexham 2. Attendance 5,516. This match ended almost in darkness with the two goals **David Jones** scored for Wrexham and **Billy Gordon** equaliser with only seven minutes to go.

Hardly anyone could see **Gren Jones** as he scored what should have been the winner. Then **Gordon** struck again to save Barrow's unbeaten home record.

Barrow were riding high near the top of Division Three (North). Wrexham had still not named the new manager.

## ROTHERHAM 2 WREXHAM 2

**Evening Leader** (*Reg Herbert*) — Wrexham showed the Yorkshire side just why they are surely the aristocrats of the Third Division and most pleasing of all they showed the hundreds of Wrexham fans in the crowd that they have the steel to fight back when the odds looked against them.

**Shropshire Star** (*David Lovett*) — Rotherham and Wrexham produced a four-goal thriller at Millmoor on Saturday. And although there were four bookings this never degenerated into the rumpus of last season when three men were sent off, two after the final whistle. Indeed it is no exaggeration to report the score could so easily have been 3—2 to Wrexham in the opening 25 minutes.

**News of the World** — With Wrexham underlining the fact that they top Division III on merit, this was a riproaring game which had just about everything to commend it.

Despite the slowly hardening ground and the inevitable slips, there was super entertainment from both teams with the only blot the booking of four players.

**Sunday People** — This was magnificent entertainment and a real credit to Third Division football.

The drama which characterised the start kept right up to the end as both sides made their contributions of thrills, spills, honest effort and exciting football.

**Sunday Mirror** — Table-topping Wrexham were denied a last-minute penalty yesterday when Rotherham defender **John Green** clearly handled, but was not seen by the referee.

But if the Welsh Wizards had grabbed both points, it would have been rough justice on the Yorkshiremen, who rose to the big occasion and helped serve up a soccer feast.

**Liverpool Daily Post** — The goal visibly rocked Wrexham but not for long and in the 56th minute were level thanks to a brilliant solo goal by **Graham Whittle**. He raced through the Rotherham defence to hit an unstoppable shot into the corner of the net from fully 30 yards.

**Wrexham Leader** (*Ron Chaloner*) — When **Green** handled, the referee, **Gordon Napthine**, of Sibley, Leicestershire, hesitated and seemed about to blow his whistle — but he did not. Perhaps he was not certain about the offence because he might have been partially unsighted, but a linesman who was in a perfect position to judge had no excuse for not flagging.

# Swindon want to avenge that league defeat

Swindon Town go into tonight's tie determined to realise a twin goal. Their first incentive is to square the record after losing 2—1 at The Racecourse in the League two months ago.

Manager **Danny Williams** reckons the earlier reverse could act as the best possible spur this evening.

## GOOD RESULT

"The lads felt that we could have easily have got a draw or even won that game and they want to prove the point by getting a good result" he said.

Swindon will also be bidding for a place in the last eight of The League Cup for the first time since they won the competition in 1969.

## ATTRACTIVE

"Whatever the outcome it should be a cracker of a tie" added Williams. "Because like us Wrexham are a side who play flowing and attractive football," he said.

Williams knows all about cup battling after guiding Swindon to Wembley in his first spell as Town's manager.

And he's not the only man at the County Ground with first hand memories of the day when Third Division Swindon toppled First Division Arsenal 3—1 after extra time.

## GOING STRONG

**Frank Burrows** centre back in the cup-winning side is now first team coach, and long serving full-back **John Trollope** is still going strong as a player after clocking up more than 800 appearances for the club.

Despite the wretched away form in the Third Division Swindon have been rampant in the cup. After trimming Swansea 3—1 at Vetch Field they won the second leg 2—1 to go through 5—2 on aggregate in the first round.

They then thrashed Second Division Cardiff City 5-1 at home before drawing 1—1 at Portsmouth in the Third Round.

## LEADERS

At the end of a thrilling replay they stormed through 4—3 winners to meet Wrexham. The scoring spree has put **Trevor Anderson** with five goals and **David Moss** with four among the leading League Cup marksmen in the country.




