

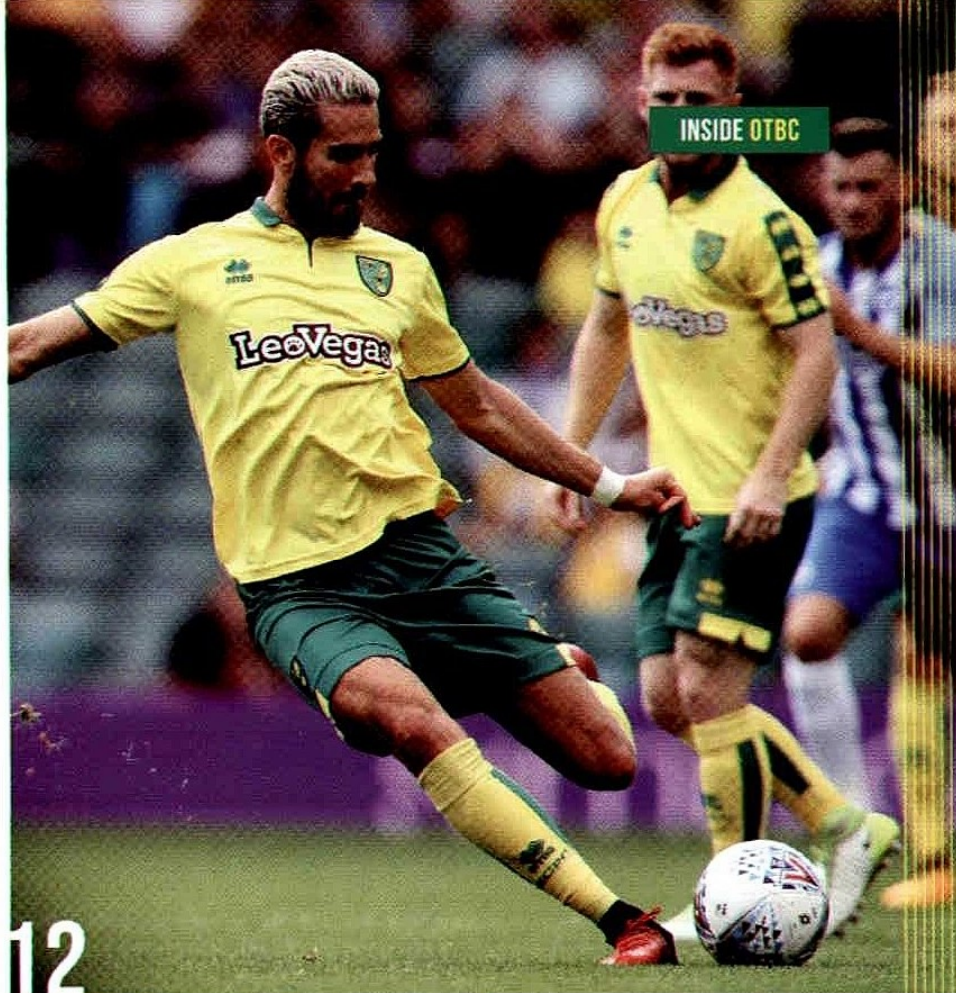

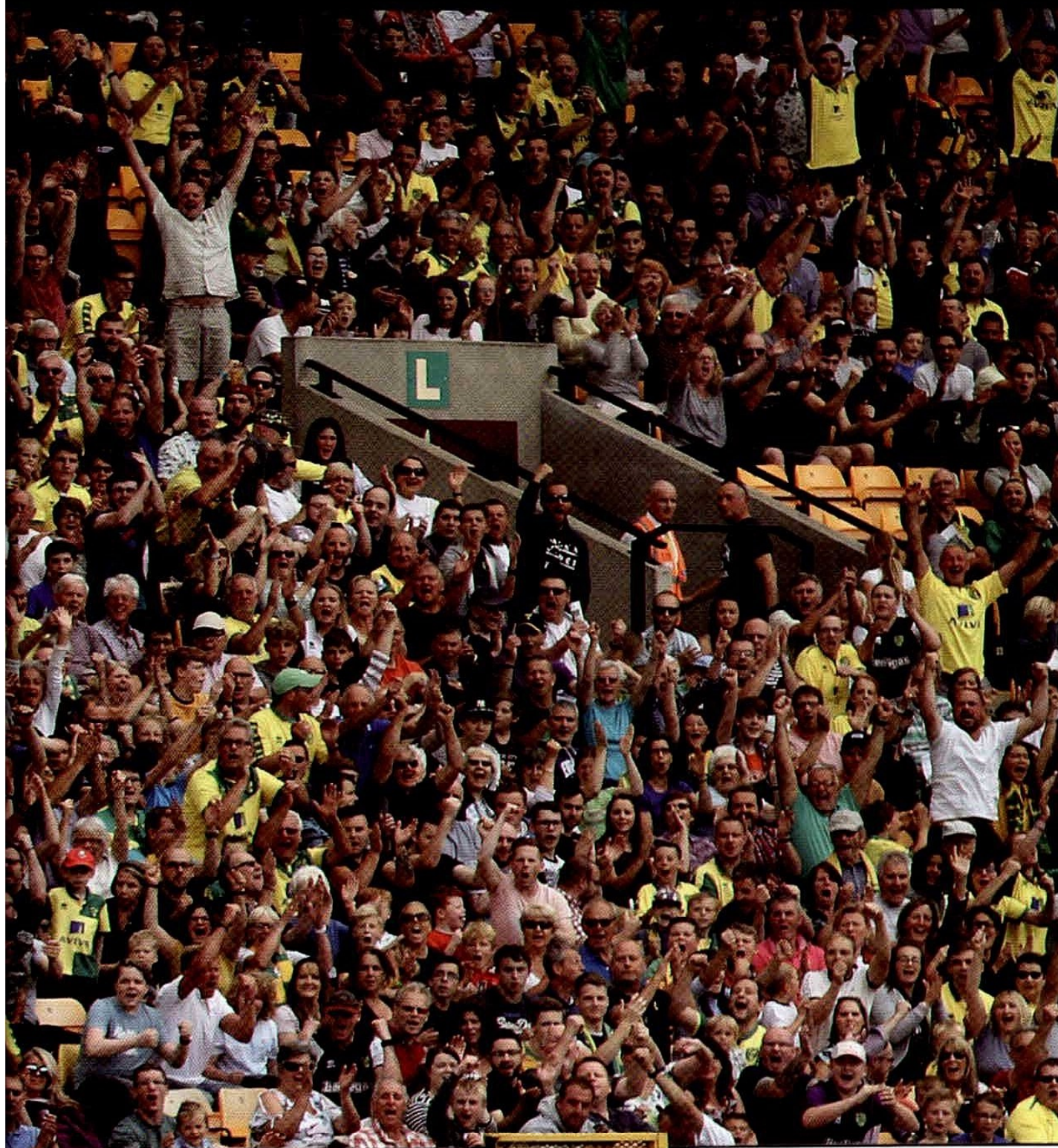

THE MANAGER DAVID FLITCROFT

EX-MIDFIELDER DAVID FLITCROFT IS EMBARKING ON HIS FIRST SEASON IN CHARGE AT THE COUNTY GROUND


Flitcroft made his name as a player with spells at Chester City, Rochdale and Bury before retiring in 2011. Midway through the 2006-07 season Flitcroft re-joined Rochdale as an assistant coach in what was his second spell at the club after playing at Spotland between 1999-2003. However, the Bolton-born man juggled his coaching role with featuring in a handful of games as a player. His last match was a cameo performance in a Football League Trophy game against Bradford City.

After periods on the coaching staff at Rochdale and Barnsley, Flitcroft was appointed as full-time manager of the Oakwell-club at the end of the 2012-13 season, guiding The Tykes to Championship safety on the final game of the season. He was sacked the following season after a defeat to Birmingham City in November before being announced as the manager of Bury in December 2013. Flitcroft led The Shakers back to League One after the 2015-16 season before joining Swindon Town on June 5 2017.

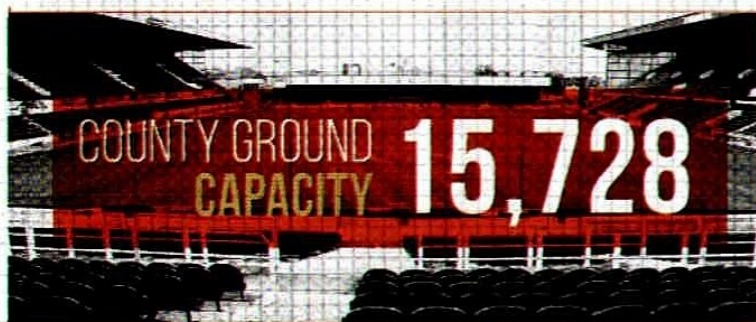

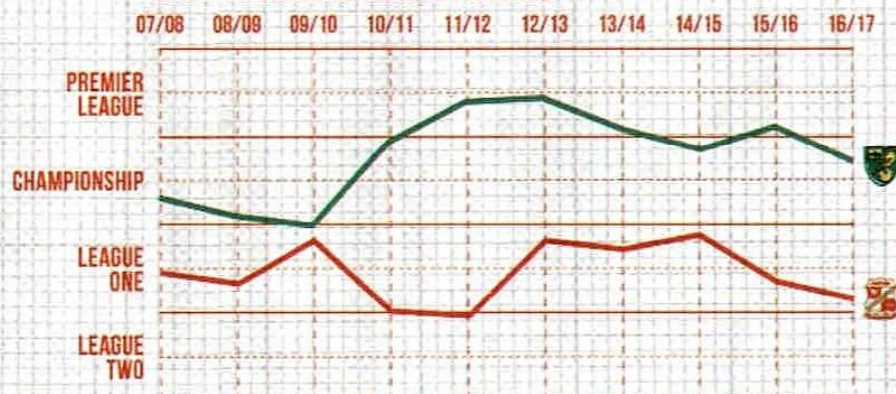

2nd November 11, 1972: Home v Ipswich – drew 0-0, don't remember much apart from I didn't like those blue and white shirts!

3rd February 10, 1973: Home v West Ham – lost 0-1 and realised for the first time that the cushions in the old Main Stand weren't just for sitting on.

THREE FAVOURITE CURRENT PLAYERS

3rd Steven Naismith: Being half Scottish I always like to see a snarling, angry Scot in yellow and green. A modern-day Flecky

2nd Ivo Pinto: So good to see a player with a smile on his face and appreciating how lucky he is to play for Norwich

1st Wes Hoolahan: Bit obvious but the man's a genius and I feel privileged to have seen him play for us. Have told my children they'll bore their children with tales of Wes.

THREE FAVOURITE PLAYERS OF ALL TIME

3rd Grant Holt: He came, he saw, he conquered.

2nd Ian Culverhouse: Can still see his goal v Mike Walker's Everton bobbling into the net and his shocked reaction that he'd actually scored. Consistently consistent.

1st Darren Huckerby: No other player has got me off my seat as much. Terrified the opposition and his legend has grown since retiring.

3rd Mathias Svensson: Other new players that joined us the season came in with a much bigger fanfare, but he was class and that goal at home v Wigan was a thing of beauty.

1st Robert Rosario: Always saw him as a players' player. Sure plenty of others scored goals thanks to his efforts

THREE REGRETS

3rd Letting Dale Gordon run rings round me when I played for Acle Cubs (my children may be under the impression that I had him in my back pocket each time).

2nd January 16, 2010: Away v Colchester. Being the dutiful father, I took the family to the cinema to see Avatar instead. Always hated that film.

1st May 1, 1982: Away v Leicester. I was 'lucky' to go to a school that had lessons on a Saturday morning. Dad wouldn't let me skive off to join him on the trip. We won 4-1 and I was gutted!

THREE FAVOURITE GOALS

3rd April 17, 2010: Michael Nelson v Charlton away – not the prettiest of goals but such a cathartic one after the visit there twelve months earlier

2nd March 24, 1993: John Polston v Aston Villa home. I really believed that we were going to win the Premier League when that went in.

1st December 27, 1986: Kevin Drinkell v Man Utd away. Somehow, we had seats in the main stand at Old Trafford and we went loopy when Drinks scored very late on. Believe it's the first goal I saw my Dad jump up and celebrate.

THREE CITY MATCHES YOU WISH YOU COULD CHANGE THE RESULT OF

3rd September 29, 2012: Liverpool at home – it wasn't my fault that my in-laws got married 50 years ago on that day. It wasn't my fault that they had their Golden Wedding party on a Saturday when Norwich were playing at home. I had an easy choice to make but it would have been easier for them to accept it if we hadn't lost 5-2 to a Gnasher Suarez inspired Liverpool.

2nd March 12, 1983: FA Cup quarter-final v Brighton away – Jimmy Case was offside. End of. Was my main discussion with Brighton fans on the train back from the Amex last season, not the 5-0 drubbing that afternoon.

1st February 18, 1984: FA Cup 5th round v Derby away – awful pitch, awful performance and still the only game I have given up watching at.

THREE FAVOURITE AWAY GROUNDS

3rd Ricoh Arena: the first away game all my three children came to. I feared it would be the last as Social Services were bound to hear about the feckless father allowing his three children to stand on their seats to shout obscenities at James Scowcroft.

2nd Highbury: an all-time classic ground.

1st San Siro: even now I can't believe I saw Norwich play there.
